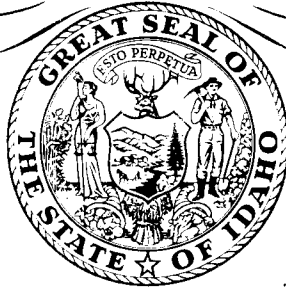

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **McCall** in the County of **Valley** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

## MCCELL CONSERVATIVE BAPTIST CHURCH MCCELL, IDAHO, INC.

At a special meeting of all interested parties at the Legion Hall in McCall, Idaho at the hour of 8:00 P.M. on December 13th, 1964, a motion was made and seconded and passed by unanimous vote that the undersigned trustees be authorized and directed to execute and file Articles of Incorporation, Incorporating the group assembled as the MCCELL CONSERVATIVE BAPTIST CHURCH of McCall, Idaho, a non-profit corporation, under the laws of the State of Idaho, Title 30, Chapter II, of the Idaho Code.

Now therefore, the undersigned:

Trustees over the age of 21 years and citizens of the United States and of the State of Idaho, being the designated and authorized persons, do hereby execute and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation of the MCCELL CONSERVATIVE BAPTIST CHURCH of McCall, Idaho as follows:

### ARTICLE-I NAME

The name of this organization, a Corporation shall be THE MCCELL CONSERVATIVE BAPTIST CHURCH of McCall, Idaho, Inc.

### ARTICLE-II-PURPOSE

The purpose of this Church shall be:

1. Provide worship services where the word of GOD is taught and Preached.
2. Provide a Christian Education program through the establishment of a Sunday School, Youth Meetings, Home Bible Classes, Vacation Bible School, Camping Program, Bible Institute and a Christian Day School as we are enabled and Directed by the LORD.
3. Help in the spread of the Gospel of the LORD JESUS CHRIST to the uttermost parts of the Earth.
4. Help in meeting the needs of the poor and the aged as the LORD directs and provides.

### ARTICLE III- MEMBERSHIP

The membership of this Church shall consist of believers in the LORD JESUS CHRIST who have been Immersed; and acknowledge substantial agreement with the Faith and Practices of this Church, its Covenants and By-Laws; and have been received into its fellowship by regular action of the Church.

### ARTICLE IV- OFFICERS

The Scriptural Officers of this Church are: PASTOR and DEACONS, and the By-Laws shall determine their election, term of Office and succession. The Trustees shall be chosen from among the Deacons and shall not be less than three ( 3 ) in number or less than one-third of the total number of Deacons.



The members of this corporation shall have the right to elect or appoint officers and directors and to remove or suspend any officer or director elected or appointed by them. The members shall also have the right to elect or appoint a committee of three or more persons to investigate and report to the corporation any alleged violation of the laws of the State of New York or of the Federal Government or of any other State or Territory or of any foreign country. The powers of this corporation shall include, but not be limited to the following:

1. To acquire, own, lease, hold, convey, and dispose of real and personal property.
2. To make, execute, and deliver any instrument in writing.
3. To purchase and use all such funds as may be necessary for the carrying on of its business in the furtherance of the corporate purposes.
4. To issue and sell bonds, notes, and other securities for the purpose of raising money for the corporation.
5. To do all such other acts and things as may be necessary or proper for the carrying on of its business.

### ARTICLE V

This corporation shall be located in the County of New York, and the principal office thereof shall be at 111 West 42nd Street, New York City. The corporation shall be organized in accordance with the laws of the State of New York. In the event of dissolution, all assets shall be conveyed to the Corporation for the benefit of the State of New York.

### ARTICLE VI

The Corporation shall have the right to sue and be sued, and to defend itself in any court of law or equity. The Corporation shall also have the right to make, execute, and deliver any instrument in writing. The Corporation shall also have the right to purchase and use all such funds as may be necessary for the carrying on of its business. The Corporation shall also have the right to issue and sell bonds, notes, and other securities for the purpose of raising money for the corporation. The Corporation shall also have the right to do all such other acts and things as may be necessary or proper for the carrying on of its business.




