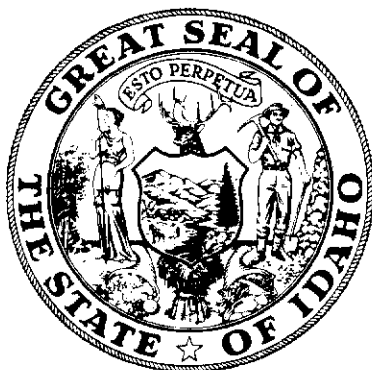

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH
OF LEWISTON, INCORPORATED

The undersigned desiring to form a nonprofit corporation under the nonprofit corporation law of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify:

Art. 1

The name of this corporation shall be "First Christian Church of Lewiston, Incorporated" and its location and chief place of business shall be 707 Seventh Avenue, Lewiston, Nez Perce County, Idaho. The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

Art. 2

All members of the Christian Church in good standing shall be admitted to membership in this corporation on application thereof for according to the custom and practice of the Christian Church.

Art. 3

Said corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision as any future U. S. Internal Revenue Law.)

Art. 4

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third thereof. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future U. S. Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future U. S. Internal Revenue Law.)

Art. 5

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purpose of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization, or organizations organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future U. S. Internal Revenue Law), as the Trustees of this corporation shall determine.

Art. 6

The officers of this corporation shall be elders, deacons, and deaconesses who together shall constitute a board to conduct the business of the corporation and to be known as the official board of the congregation. They shall be elected by the members of the congregation constituting the corporation at such time and such numbers and for such terms and their powers and duties shall be such as may be determined by the congregation.

The initial registered agent of the corporation shall be Martin A. Anderson, Lewiston Grain Growers, 1200 Snake River Avenue, Lewiston, ID 83501. The incorporator of this corporation shall be Martin A. Anderson, who's address is set out as:
