AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates  
and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service  
Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30,  
Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TWIN FALLS IDAHO CONGREGATION  
OF JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES, INC.  
A NON PROFIT CORPORATION

KNOW ALL YE, That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Idaho and in pursuance of the purposes for which we have been elected, as hereinafter set forth, a benevolent, charitable, educational, christian and philanthropic corporation to be known as : Twin Falls Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, Inc.

AND WE CERTIFY; That the objects for which this corporation is formed is to further preaching and teaching the Gospel of God's Kingdom, and proclaiming the over-all Supremacy of Almighty God, Jehovah: to conduct schools and classes for teaching and to teach the Bible and Bible Truths: to by, sell, or give away and otherwise distribute Bibles and other literature concerning and containing information and comment explaining Bible Truths, and prophesy concerning establishment of Jehovah's Kingdom under Christ Jesus: to hold title to real property, and to construct and erect buildings and facilities thereon for the purpose of carrying out the general purpose of the corporation, to pledge or mortgage the real or personal property of the corporation for the purpose of procuring money or property to be used for the furtherance of the purposes of the corporation; to take, receive, hold and disburse donations, and contributions of money and property, bequests and legacies to further the purposes of the corporation, which purposes are wholly benevolent, charitable, educational, christian and philanthropic, and not in any sense for profit; to further the purposes herein avowed and set forth, by means of written or spoken word, picture, television, radio or otherwise, and to own and operate printing press, radio, television and other apparatus and devices for conveying thought, and the giving expression of thought and of particular things, and to do any and all things lawfully to be done to further the herein avowed and declared purposes of the corporation; to take charge of the buildings, estate and property of the corporation, and the affairs of the temporalities thereof, and to do all things useful and necessary to be done to further efficient and business like management thereof.

That the business of this corporation is to be conducted wholly on a non profit basis.

That the principal place of business of the corporation shall be in the City of Twin Falls, County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho.

That the term of incorporation shall be fifty years.

That the number of directors who shall have management of its affairs as aforesaid shall be five, and the names of the directors elected and the number of years for which they were and are elected is as follows:

Harry Stradley, of Twin Falls, Idaho, elected for a term of three years.  
Kenneth Gressley, of Twin Falls, Idaho, elected for a term of three years.  
Orville Doty, of Twin Falls, Idaho, elected for a term of two years.  
Ike Grist, of Twin Falls, Idaho, elected for a term of two years.  
Laval Hollinger, of Twin Falls, Idaho, elected for a term of one year.

That the above named directors were elected at a meeting held at the regular meeting place of the Twin Falls Idaho Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, Inc. on Tuesday the seventeenth day of July, 1956, notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting having been duly and legally published in the Times News, a newspaper regularly printed and published in Twin Falls County, State of Idaho, and of general circulation in the City of Twin Falls, the place where a great majority of the members of the Twin Falls, Idaho Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses, Inc. reside, and the publication in said Twin Falls County most likely to give notice to said members of said meeting and election, and a like notice was posted on the building at which said meeting and election was noticed to be held, in a conspicuous place for the same length of time that it was published, to-wit, for a period of two weeks immediately preceeding said meeting and election: that a majority of the members of the Twin Falls Idaho Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses Inc. were present at said meeting, and voted in the election of the directors hereinabove named, and on all other questions relating to the organization of said corporation as fully appears in the verified certificate of the officers who conducted said meeting and election, hereunto annexed and made a part of these articles.

Orville Doty and James Partridge, both being duly sworn, each for himself says:

I hereby certify that Orville Doty and James Partridge, were chairman and secretary respectively of a meeting of the members of the Twin Falls Idaho Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses Inc. duly convened for the purposes hereinafter set forth, held at the regular meeting place of said organization, at 233 Main West, Twin Falls, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho, on Tuesday the seventeenth day of July, 1956.

Orville Doty, the regularly elected Congregation Servant in the discharge of his duty as Congregation Servant, according to the custom and practice of said organization called the meeting to order and presided over its deliberations. At the request of the chairman James Partridge acted as secretary of the meeting and recorded its proceedings.

A resolution was unanimously adopted that a corporation be organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho, to be known as Twin Falls Idaho Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses Inc., and that a Board of five directors be elected two to serve for a term of three years for each, two to serve for a term of two years for each and one to serve for one year, they to have charge of the incorporating of said corporation and the management thereof as is fully set forth in the foregoing articles of incorporation: that notice of said meeting and the time, place and purpose thereof was duly published and posted as required by law, and that a majority of all of the members of said organization were present at said meeting and voted in the election of the five directors named in said foregoing articles of incorporation, and also upon all questions considered and acted upon by said meeting.

I have read the foregoing and hereunto annexed articles of incorporation, and certify that all matters and things therein stated relating to the organization of said corporation, and the election of its directors are true.
