ARTICLE VII

The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 507 E. Sullivan Street, Boise, Idaho, 83706 and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is David G. Powell.

ARTICLE VIII

The Board of Directors has the power to make, repeal, amend and alter the By-laws of the Corporation, to the extent provided in the By-laws. In the event of an Election, neither any shareholder nor any of the officers of the Corporation may, without the prior written consent of the record shareholders or more than fifty percent(50%) of the then outstanding shares of stock in the Corporation, make or effect any transfer of any shares of stock in the Corporation that would cause a termination or invalidation of Election.
