

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
TRIBUNE PUBLISHING COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we the undersigned, Albert H. Alford, Eugene L. Alford, and George M. Alford, and Wallace B. Stainton, of Lewiston, Idaho have voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of the corporation shall be the
TRIBUNE PUBLISHING COMPANY.

ARTICLE II.

That the business and object of said corporation, and the purposes for which it is formed are as follows:

a. To carry on the business of publishing, printing, issuing, circulating and operating a newspaper plant and equipment, known as and called the Lewiston Morning Tribune and the Lewiston Weekly Tribune, a daily and weekly publication or managing, printing, publishing, circulating said or any other paper which the board of directors may direct under said or any other name.

b. To engage in the business of job printing and publishing books, blanks and notices of every kind and nature, and the transacting any and all business which can or might be transacted and conducted by this or any other modern newspaper plant.

c. To deal in goods, wares, merchandise, purchase, own, control, transfer, and deal in loans, securities, encumbrances, evidence of debt, and purchase, own and control real estate.

d. To buy, sell, own, control and vote stocks, bonds, debentures in this or any other corporations formed for any other purpose.

e. Finally to do any and all and everything necessary and consistent with the carrying out of the foregoing several purposes in their fullest and broadest sense, within the State of Idaho, and all other states of the United States.

ARTICLE III.

That the term for which said corporation is to exist shall be fifty years.

ARTICLE IV.

The place where the principal business of the said corporation is to be transacted shall be at the City of Lewiston, in the County of Nez Perce, State of Idaho,

ARTICLE V.

That the number of directors of said corporation shall be four, and the following named persons shall be appointed as directors thereof for the first year.

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be Thirty Thousand dollars, divided into three hundred shares of the par value of \$100.00 each.
