ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SHAW - INGLE. INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to that end do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the proposed corporation is SHAW - INGLE, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purposes of the corporation are as follows:

- To take, buy, exchange, lease or otherwise acquire (1) real property and any interest or right therein; and to hold, own, operate, control, manage and develop said property; and to engage in all forms and types of farming or agricultural operations, including, but not limited to, raising agricultural crops of all kinds, raising, dealing in and managing livestock and poultry; buying, selling, exchanging and otherwise dealing in agricultural crops, products and produce, farming and ranching equipment, machinery, and all types of commodities, goods, and merchandise in anywise connected with the operation of a farm, ranch or agricultural pursuit; and to buy, sell, exchange, lease, or otherwise acquire or deal in, buildings, offices, warehouses, mills, shops, factories, machinery and plants, and any and all structures or erections which may at any time be necessary, useful, or advantageous for the purposes of this corporation.
- (2) To subscribe for, acquire by purchase, or otherwise, and to own, hold, sell, assign, and transfer shares of the capital stock of this or any other corporation, and to exercise all the rights of the stockholders; to acquire by purchase or otherwise hold and dispose of stock, bonds, and all other types of securities, and to make, accept, endorse, execute, and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds, debentures or other obligations from time to time, for the purchase of property, or for any purpose in or about the business of the corporation.

- (3) To enter into and perform contracts for the construction of roads, streets, highways, buildings and all types of general construction work, and to acquire and to generally deal in, and to lease operate and maintain construction machinery of all classes and descriptions, and to enter into all sorts of financial arrangements necessary for the acquisition, leasing or otherwise contracting for the use ownership and maintenance of heavy road and other equipment and machinery.
- (4) To engage in any business, whatsoever, either as principal or agent, or both, or as a syndicate, which the corporation may deem convenient or proper in the furtherance of any of the purposes hereinabove mentioned or otherwise; to conduct its business in this State, in other states, in the District of Columbia, in the territories and possessions of the United States, and in foreign countries; and to have and to exercise all powers authorized by the laws of the State of Idaho under which the corporation is formed, whether expressly set forth in this article or not, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.

ARTICLE III

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the office of the corporation in the State of Idaho is Bruneau, Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The authorized capital of the corporation is the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) represented by One Thousand (1,000) shares of common stock of no par value. Said stock shall be non-assessable.

ARTICLE VI

The name and post office address of each of the incorporators and the number of shares for which each has subscribed are as follows:

Each of said incorporators is over the age of twenty-one and is a citizen of the United States.

ARTICLE VII

The corporation shall have the power to purchase its own stock in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho, as are now in effect or may be hereinafter enacted.

In case a stockholder desires to sell a share or shares of stock he must first offer them for sale to the remaining stockholders, it being the intention to give the remaining stockholders a preference in the purchase of the same, and any attempted sale in violation of this provision is null and void. A stockholder desiring to sell his stock shall file notice in writing of his intention with the Secretary of the corporation, stating the terms of sale, and unless his terms are accepted by any or all of the other stockholders within thirty days thereafter, they shall be deemed to have waived their preference of purchase of said stock and the stockholder shall be at liberty to sell to anyone else on the same terms as those offered to the other stockholders.

ARTICLE VIII

The method and manner of holding Directors' meetings and stockholders' meetings, the authority and duties of each of the officers of the corporation, and all other matters for management

and control of the corporation shall be determined by the By-Laws of the corporation and by the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IX

These articles may be amended in any respect conformable to the laws of the State of Idaho by a vote of the required percentage of stockholders as required by the laws of the State of Idaho then entitled to vote at a meeting of stockholders called for that purpose as prescribed by law.
