ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a Corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, (Chapter 3, Title 30, Idaho Code), hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I
NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the Corporation shall be and is CITIZENS FOR NUCLEAR TECHNOLOGY UNDERSTANDING, INC.; the acronym CNTU, as may be used from time to time, shall mean and refer to the full name of the corporation as set forth in this Article.

ARTICLE II
DURATION

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III
NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

ARTICLE IV
PURPOSES

A. The general purposes for which this Corporation is organized are exclusively for nuclear related education and scientific purposes in nonprofit activities consistent with and within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. 501(c)(3)) and the regulations promulgated thereunder (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are as follows:

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SECRETARY OF STATE
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(a) To be the voice of community supporters of:

(i) the United States Department of Energy's (DOE) Idaho National Engineering and Environmental Laboratory (INEEL), Argonne National Laboratory-West (ANL-West), and the Naval Reactors Facility (NRF), situated within DOE'S 572,000 acre site (hereinafter "INEEL Site", or "the site") a contiguous unit occupying parts of five (5) Idaho counties in Eastern Idaho, and with other offices and facilities in surrounding areas, cities and counties in Eastern Idaho, and their contractors, subcontractors, spin-off organizations and University Consortia; and

(ii) the safe and environmentally sound nuclear technology development and use;

(b) To support the government, both Federal and State, and their contractors at the INEEL Site in achieving environmental goals to clean up the legacy of fifty (50) years of research and development activity;

(c) To provide scientific factual information and to correct misconceptions about nuclear technology and its use;

(d) To enhance education and public understanding of the INEEL Site and its associated nuclear technology firms performing nuclear activities at the site.

(e) To provide information and support for new missions at the INEEL Site and for creation of new private sector industries in Idaho from INEEL Site research and development;

(f) To provide citizens' input to DOE Project and Environmental documents to constructively impact the decision making process;

(g) To review academic, professional and scientific reports and publications to better enable performance of its objectives;

(h) To cooperate with similar nonprofit organizations supporting nuclear technology, and other DOE Laboratories, for the public interest;

(i) To do all things necessary or convenient not inconsistent with the law, to further the activities and affairs of the Corporation.

B. No part of the income, profits or net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors or officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in paragraph A. of this Article. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on

behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. 501 (c)(3)) (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. 170(c)(2)) or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE V
NONSTOCK CORPORATION

The Corporation shall be nonstock and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared or paid to the members thereof.

ARTICLE VI
MEMBERSHIP

Business entities, nonprofit citizens organizations with similar goals and objectives and families from all walks of life will be considered for membership in the Corporation. The conditions and regulations of membership and the rights and other privileges of the classes of memberships shall be determined and fixed by the bylaws of the Corporation. The corporation will consist of voting members.

ARTICLE VII
INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The address of the initial registered office in the State of Idaho is 115 North Ridge, #180, City of Idaho Falls, County of Bonneville, State of Idaho, 83401 and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is Charles M. Rice.

ARTICLE VIII
DIRECTORS

(a) The number of directors of this Corporation shall be that number designated by the Board of Directors from time to time as set forth in the bylaws of the Corporation

(b) The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is three (3) and the names, addresses and the length of the term each is to serve, are as follows:

(c) The initial chairman of the Board of Directors shall be Frank C. Fogarty who shall serve in that capacity until the end of the initial meeting of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IX
OFFICERS OF THE CORPORATION AND THEIR FUNCTIONS

The titles of each of the officers of the Corporation and the function of each shall be set forth in the bylaws of the Corporation as amended from time to time as provided therein.

ARTICLE X
INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify each officer and director, including former officers and directors, to the full extent permitted by the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, and any other Idaho statute which at such time be applicable to such indemnification, as determined by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XI
DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the assets of the Corporation remaining after payments of any debts of the Corporation shall be distributed to a qualified charitable or educational organization(s) meeting the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. §501(c)(3)) or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law as the Board of Directors shall determine, provided that should any of such assets have been acquired under a Federal Grant or contract their disposition shall be made in accordance with the appropriate instructions of the government official from whom those instructions were provided.

ARTICLE XII
AMENDMENTS


These Articles may be amended in the manner provided by Idaho statute at the time of amendment.






