CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, JAS H. YOUNG, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

GETHSEMANE BAPTIST CHURCH, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **3rd** day of **April** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-eight** and is duly recorded on Film No. **102** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Idaho Falls** in the County of **Bonneville** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
GETHSEMANE BAPTIST CHURCH, INC.

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We, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, who are associated together as a church, not for pecuniary profit, hereby incorporate ourselves under the Religious, Social and Benevolent Corporations Act of the State of Idaho (§§30-1101ff. I.C.)

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Gethsemane Baptist Church, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- A. To bring all men into a personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour.
- B. To conduct religious worship and to provide a place therefor.
- C. To establish, maintain and conduct schools for religious education.
- D. To preach and teach the Whole Council of God, as set forth in the Old and New Testaments of the Holy Bible, to its members and to the community.
- E. To promote the spiritual, moral, intellectual and physical growth and well-being of its members and of the communities in which they reside.
- F. To promote a spirit of brotherhood between the members of the corporation and respect for the individual freedoms of all men.
- G. To receive gifts and grants of money and property of every kind and to administer the same for religious,

charitable, educational and civic purposes.

H. To own real estate, in the furtherance of the purposes herein stated; to improve the same and to construct church buildings, personages, libraries, gymnasiums, schools, camp and retreat facilities and playgrounds thereon.

I. To buy, sell, manage, lease, convey, or encumber such property as may be necessary to carry out the purposes stated herein and to execute such contracts, deeds, mortgages, notes, or other instruments as might be necessary therefor.

J. To do any and all other things necessary in furtherance of the purposes hereinbefore stated, not inconsistent with the corporation laws of the state of Idaho.

ARTICLE III

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation shall be Idaho Falls, Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall not issue stock and no dividends or pecuniary profit shall be declared or paid to the members thereof.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VII

The management and business affairs of the corporation shall be conducted by a board of directors, to be known as a board of trustees, which board shall consist of not less than three

persons, each of whom shall be a member of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

An election for such directors (trustees) was held on April 1, 1958, at 8 p.m., in the council chamber of the City Building, Idaho Falls, Idaho. A majority of the members of said church who were present at the meeting at which such election was held voted in said election, which voting resulted in the election to the first board of trustees, of: John B. Pierce, William S. Little and Richard A. Porter. The secretary of said meeting was Carole J. Logsdon. Prior to the holding of such election, notice of the time and place thereof was given by publication once each calendar week on the same day of the week, for two weeks, in The Post-Register, a daily newspaper published at Idaho Falls, where such election was held and also by posting for two weeks a like notice, in a conspicuous place on the building where such election was held. Said notice was as follows:
