#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF
EQUIPMENT SALES AND SERVICE INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all citizens of the United States of legal age, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a domestic corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Idaho, and

WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST

The name of this corporation is Equipment Sales and Service Inc.

SECOND

This corporation is formed for profit.

THIRD

That the nature of the business and the objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- 1. To operate and maintain a business for the purpose of buying and selling machinery and other personal property, both retain and wholesale; to operate, service and maintain the same, and generally to do any and all things necessary and proper to be done in the business for which it is incorporated and other useful and beneficial purposes.
- 2. To take, own, hold, deal in, mortgage, lease, sell, exchange, transfer or in any manner dispose of real property, lease holds, and any other interests, estates and rights in real property, to purchase or acquire in any lawful manner, and to hold, own, mortgage, pledge, lease, sell, assign, exchange, transfer, and in any manner dispose of, to deal and trade in and with any and every class of personal property and/or mixed property, and any franchises, water rights, water permits, water licenses, or privileges necessary, convenient or appropriate for any of the purposes herein expressed.
- 3. To borrow money and to make and issue notes, bonds, debentures, obligations and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by

mortgage, pledge or otherwise, without limit as to amount, and to secure same by mortgage, pledge, or otherwise, and generally to make and perform agreements and contracts of every kind and nature.

4. To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or other individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business or powers, or any part thereof, provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

## FOURTH

The existence of this corporation is to be perpetual.

### FIFTH

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be at Rupert, County of Minidoka, State of Idaho.

#### SIXTH

The capital stock of this corporation shall be of the total value of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, divided into One Hundred (100) Shares of the par value of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars each.

At all meetings of the stockholders cumulative voting shall be allowed and each stockholder may vote by written proxy.

## SEVENTH

That the amount of the capital stock which has been actually subscribed and paid for is the sum of \$15,000.00, and following are the names of the persons, their addresses and the number of shares by whom same have been subscribed, to-wit:

The management of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors of not less than three (3) or not more than seven (7) directors, as may be fixed by the By-Laws. The directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the stockholders, to be held at the general office of this corporation in the said village of Rupert, Idaho, on the 1st day of April at the hour of 7:00 o'clock p.m. each year, and until the first election of directors to be held on the 1st day of April, 1966, the directors of said corporation shall be the said Stanley B. Bonham, Verniss Culley and Odell Warr. The office held by each shall be Stanley B. Bonham, President; Verniss Culley, Vice President; and Odell Ware, Secretary and Treasurer.

The Board of Directors are empowered to repeal, amend and adopt By-Laws. The stockholders, too, are empowered to repeal, amend and adopt By-Laws.
