

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The name of this corporation is PIPE LININGS, INC.

ΙI

Restriction of right to shand articles

The purposes for which this corporation is formed

- (a) The primary business in which the corporation intends to engage and which is and shall be among the purposes for which the corporation is formed is: To carry on a general pipe lining business and to line the interiors of pipes and conduits of all kinds, whether new or old and whether in place or not, and to line the interiors of special parts, fittings or appurtenances for pipes and conduits and to provide and install protective coating or covering for pipes and conduits and for special parts, fittings or appurtenances for pipes and conduits and conduits.
- (b) To conduct, carry on and be engaged in general contracting, construction and engineering businesses in all their respective branches, and to engage in all work and business incidental thereto and useful in connection therewith.
- (c) To acquire as factor, commission agent or broker, or on and for its own account, by purchase or otherwise, sell, lease, manufacture, produce, build, assemble, fabricate, install, and deal in and deal with, export and import, pipe, wire, machinery, equipment, lime, cement,

concrete, plaster, sand, gravel, stone, marble, brick, terra cotta, lumber, timber, glass, plastics, resins, protective coatings, linings, paints, oils, varnishes, stains, iron, steel, copper, brass, zinc, lead and all other metals, products, substances and any combination thereof, and building materials, supplies, devices, appliances, goods, wares, merchandise and personal property of every sort, nature and description.

- (d) To acquire real property by purchase, lease or otherwise, to own, hold, lease, operate, improve, develop, subdivide, exchange, sell and otherwise dispose of, to mortgage, deed in trust or otherwise encumber, and generally, in any and every way to invest in, own and deal in and with real estate, both improved and unimproved, lease and leasehold interests, oil rights and water rights and all rights, interests, estates and equities therein, and to acquire, install and operate supply houses, warehouses, plants, factories, transportation facilities, and living quarters and commissaries for its use and the use of its employees and others.
- (e) To lend money and negotiate loans with or without security and with or without interest; to draw, accept, endorse, discount, buy, sell and deliver bills of exchange, promissory notes, bonds, debentures, coupons and other negotiable instruments and securities; to purchase, acquire, own, hold, guarantee, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, piedge or otherwise dispose of and deal in, shares (including the shares of this corporation), bonds, notes, debentures, and shares and interests in unincorpo-

rated companies and trusts, or other securities or evidences of indebtedness of any other person, corporation or association, whether domestic or foreign, and whether now or hereafter organized or existing; and while the holder thereof, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote thereon, to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.

- (f) To borrow money, to issue bonds, notes, debenture; or other obligations of this corporation from time to time for any of the objects or purposes of this corporation, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or otherwise, or to issue the same unsecured.
- (g) To acquire, hold, use, sell, assign, lease, grant licenses in respect of, mortgage or otherwise dispose of letters patent of the United States or any foreign country, patent rights, licenses and privileges, inventions, improvements and processes, copyrights, trademarks and trade names, relating to or useful in connection with any business of this corporation.
- (h) To acquire, by purchase or otherwise, the goodwill, business, property rights, franchises and assets of every kind, with or without undertaking to discharge, either wholly or in part, the liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation; and to acquire any business as a going concern or otherwise: (1) by purchase of the assets thereof, wholly or in part; (2) by acquisition of the shares or any part thereof; or (3) in any other manner; and to pay for the same in cash or in the shares or bonds or other evidences of indebtedness of this cor-

poration, or otherwise; to hold, maintain, and operate, or in any manner dispose of, the whole or any part of the goodwill, business, rights and property so acquired, and to conduct in any lawful manner the whole or any part of any business so acquired; and to exercise all the powers necessary or convenient in and about the management of such business.

- (i) To engage in any undertaking or business of a joint adventurer partner, limited partner, or otherwise, with any person, firm or corporation, and to conduct its business, or any part thereof, or any business in which it is engaged as a joint adventurer, partner, limited partner, or otherwise, under such fictitious name or names as may be determined upon from time to time.
- (,) To promote or to aid in any manner, financially or otherwise, any person, partnership, joint adventure, association or corporation, and for this purpose to guarantee the contracts, dividends, shares, bonds, debentures, notes and other obligations of such other persons, partnerships, joint adventures, associations or corporations.
- (k) To carry on any business whatsoever, which this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or which may be calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of this corporation or to enhance the value of its property or susiness, all without territorial limitation; and to have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of California upon a corporation formed under

the laws pursuant to and under which this corporation is formed, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.

(1) The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers and the purposes and powers stated in each clause shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause or paragraph of these articles. The objects, purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses and paragraphs of these articles shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers, and it is hereby expressly provided that the aforegoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation.

III

The county in the State of California where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located is Los Angeles County.

This corporation is authorized to issue only one class of shares of stock; the total number of such shares is five thousand (5,000); and all such shares of stock are to be without par value.
