ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
AMENDING THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
PLUMMER BETHEL CHAPEL, INC.

The Articles of Incorporation of Plummer Bethel Chapel, Inc., are hereby amended as follows:

Article VI of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby repealed and the following Article is substituted in its place.

ARTICLE VI.

"In the event of dissolution of the corporation, all assets tangible and intangible remaining after the payment of all just debts, shall be given, as determined by the Board of Trustees, to one or more organizations whose statement of faith, belief, and teaching shall be similar to those of this association and who are qualified as non-profit organizations exempt from Federal income tax under Code Sec. 501 (c) (3)."

CERTIFICATE

The undersigned officers of Plummer Bethel Chapel, Inc., being duly sworn, hereby certify that the foregoing Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of said religious corporation, was adopted September 6, 1964, at a special meeting of the members of the congregation of said religious corporation, called by the Board of Trustees for the stated purpose of considering and acting upon said amendment, said meeting being held pursuant to notice thereof published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the St. Maries Gazette
