CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

SOCIEDAD CIVICA MEXICANA DE POCA TELLO, IDAHO, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Thirty-first** day of **December** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-three** and is duly recorded on Film No. **126** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Pocatello** in the County of **Bannock**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SOCIEDAD CIVICA MEXICANA DE POCATELLO, IDAHO, INC.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under Title 30, Chapter 10, Idaho Code, "Nonprofit Cooperative Associations," adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

I.

The name of the corporation is "Sociedad Civica Mexicana de Pocatello, Idaho, Inc.

II.

The period of its duration is perpetual.

III.

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. To foment the spirit of union among the peoples of Mexican descent or origin in the United States.
2. To maintain the good name of Mexico and of the people of Mexican descent or origin in the United States.
3. To try to better the social, moral, intellectual and economic situation of peoples of Mexican origin or descent in the United States in general.
4. To instruct the members concerning their rights and duties in the United States and the obligations they owe to the United States.
5. To organize ceremonies and festivities that will give prestige to the people of Mexican origin or descent.

IV.

The members of the corporation shall be:

1. Persons of Mexican descent or origin and/or persons of other descent or origin provided that he or she be friendly to Mexico; over the age of 18 years, without distinction as to sex, political belief and religion.

2. A resident of Pocatello or the nearby area for at least six months prior to the date of making an application for admission to membership.
3. Persons possessing the above qualifications whose application has been voted upon and accepted by a majority of the members present at a regular meeting of the corporation, whose initiation fee and membership dues are paid in full in accordance with the provisions of the bylaws.
4. Persons possessing the above qualifications whose standards of behavior are in accordance with rules as set forth in the bylaws.

V.

The rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest in said corporation than any other member. Such association or corporation shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof, which certificates cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof, can by such transfer become a member of the corporation, except by resolution of the Board of Directors or having been voted upon and accepted by a majority of the members present at a regular meeting of the corporation.

VI.

The number of directors of this corporation shall be nine, composed of the following:

The President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and five other fully qualified members of the corporation, all to be elected, qualified and to serve in accordance with the provisions of the bylaws of this corporation.

VII.

The provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including provisions for the distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation, shall be in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho relative thereto, the bylaws of this corporation and by majority vote of the membership.

VIII.

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 815 North Harrison Avenue, Pocatello, Bannock County, Idaho, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Felix Sanchez.
