ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CAMAS CHORISTERS, INC.

4 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we the undersigned,  
5 have associated and do hereby associate ourselves together for  
6 the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation, pursuant to Title  
7 30, Chapter 3 of the Idaho Code, and all laws amendatory thereof  
8 and supplementary thereto, and do hereby make, subscribe and  
9 certify as follows:

10 ARTICLE I.

11 The name of the corporation is Camas Choristers, Inc.

12 ARTICLE II.

13 The location of the registered office of the corporation  
14 shall be 810 N. Junction, Grangeville, Idaho 83530. The initial  
15 registered agent is Howard Donaldson, 810 N. Junction,  
16 Grangeville, Idaho.

17 ARTICLE III.

18 This is a nonprofit organization, no part of the  
19 incorporation of which is distributable to its members,  
20 directors, or officers.

21 ARTICLE IV.

22 This said corporation shall have perpetual existence.

23 ARTICLE V.

24 The purposes for which the corporation is formed are to do  
25 any and all things hereinafter set forth to the same extent as  
26 natural persons might or could do in any part of the world so  
27 long as the pecuniary profit is not their object, namely:

- 28 a. To promote the arts on the Camas Prairie.  
29 b. To give area artists a setting in which they can  
30 perform music and drama.  
31 c. To provide the public with musical and dramatic  
32 performances.  
d. Any money or donations to the corporation shall be  
used solely to promote the nonprofit and charitable  
purposes set forth herein. The corporation shall not  
engage in any activities procluded under the Internal

1 Revenue Code by corporations which are tax exempt, but  
2 which may receive tax exempt contributions and no  
3 substantial part of the activities of the corporation  
4 shall be to promote propaganda, or otherwise attempt  
5 to influence legislation and the corporation shall not  
6 support or oppose any candidate for public office.

7 ARTICLE VI.

8 The corporation shall be nonstock and no dividends or  
9 pecuniary profits shall be declared to the members thereof. This  
10 corporation shall issue membership certificates to each member  
11 hereof, the qualifications of being and becoming a member shall  
12 be fully set out in Bylaws of this Corporation and said  
13 certificate cannot be assigned except by resolution of the Board  
14 of Directors and under such regulations as the Bylaws may  
15 provide.

16 ARTICLE VII.

17 The general officers of the corporation shall be  
18 President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, and the  
19 offices of secretary and treasurer may be combined, and the Board  
20 of Directors shall consist of nine (9) members.

21 The principal duties of the officers of the corporation  
22 shall be the usual and regular duties as those usually prescribed  
23 for the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer of the  
24 corporation, which duties are more particularly outlined in the  
25 laws of the State of Idaho, and will be more particularly defined  
26 in the Bylaws herein adopted. Said officers shall perform such  
27 additional and different duties as shall from time to time be  
28 imposed or required by the Board of Directors or as may be  
29 prescribed from time to time by the Bylaws. Each and every  
30 officer of this corporation and member of the Board of Directors  
31 must be a member of this corporation.

32 ARTICLE VIII.

The private property of the members of the corporation  
shall not be subject to the payment of, and no member shall be

individually responsible for, corporate debts or acts to any extent whatever without his consent thereto in writing.

ARTICLE IX.

The rights and interest of all members shall be equal and no member shall have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other members.

ARTICLE X.

The Bylaws of the corporation may define and fix the duties and responsibilities of the members and prescribe such other terms and conditions upon which members shall be entitled to and retain membership in the corporation consistent with these Articles of Incorporation or the acts under which this corporation is organized.
