IDAMO FEED AND GRAIN ASSOCIATION, INC.

Citizens of the United States, residents of the State of Idaho, and of legal age, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming and incorporating a non-profit organization, under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 10, Title 30 of the State of Idaho Code, and hereby make, subscribe and execute the following Articles of Incorporation of said association, and we hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation is IDAHO FEED AND GRAIN ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

This corporation is a non-profit organization formed for benevolent, charitable, educational and fraternal purposes, and especially as follows:

- 1. To secure, perpetuate and promote the general welfare of the feed and grain dealers of the state of Idaho and surrounding and adjoining territory; to inculcate just and equitable principles of trade; to create a high standard of ethics among the members of the Corporation.
- 2. To encourage a closer acquaintance and interchange of thought and opinion by acquiring, correlating, analyzing and disseminating useful cusiness information among its members; to conduct a service program of an educational and instructive nature concerning improvements in the techniques of the feed and grain business; to better the conditions of those engaged in this business, and to aid in the development of a higher degree of efficiency in the conduct of their businesses, all for the use and benefit of feed and grain dealers and the general public; to provide an office and meeting place and other

facilities necessary or desirable for carrying out the above purposes and for the use and benefit of feed and grain dealers and the general public.

- 3. To purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own and exercise all rights and ownership in real estate and personal property, and to sell or transfer said real estate and personal property, to erect buildings or other structures necessary and proper for the carrying out of said purposes herein mentioned, and to enter into all contracts or agreements necessary to the conduct of its affairs.
- and wrain organizations, such as educational organizations, farm organizations, Chambers of Commerce, on matters of common interest that affect the conduct of the feed and grain industry; and on programs that strengthen and develop the state's agricultural and industrial economy.
- 5. To carry into effect any one or more of the purposes hereinabove set forth, and to that end, to do any one or more of the acts and things aforesaid, and likewise any and all acts and things necessary or incidental thereto, and in conducting or carrying on its operations and for the purpose of promoting or furthering any one or more of its said purposes, to exercise any or all of the above powers hereinabove set forth in this Article and any other or additional power now or hereafter authorized by law, either alone or in conjunction with others, as principal, agent, or otherwise.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, and the purposes and powers stated in each clause, except where otherwise expressed, shall be in nowise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

ARTICLE III

PLACE OF BUSINESS

The location of the principal office of the Association shall be any place designated by the Board of Directors. The registered office of the association shall be Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

TIME OF EXISTENCE

The time for which this corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation does not have, and shall not have, any capital stock; neither shall it issue capital stock to its members, or certificates representing capital stock, and this corporation shall not be operated for pecuniary profit.

ARTICLE VI

MEMBERSHIP

This association shall, by its Ey-Laws be empowered to determine and regulate the qualifications of its members and the fees or dues for admission as provided by section 30-1004 Idaho code. The organization shall be sustained by the payment, by each member, of an annual membership fee and shall be empowered to issue such certificates or evidence of membership as may be lawfully authorized by its By-Laws, and the rights and interests of all members shall be equal.

The officers and members of this corporation shall not be individually or personally liable for any debts or liabilities of the corporation except as to the extent of the amount of dues or membership fees unpaid by such member or members.

ARTICLE VII

DIRECTORS

The number of directors of this corporation shall not be less than nine (9) more more than twenty-four (24), and the term of office, qualifications of directors and manner of election shall be provided for in the Ey-Laws.
