Bert S. Stone and Marie Gauer Stone, being each duly sworn, on his respective oath does depose and say as follows:

That the said Bert S. Stone is the duly elected and acting President of Stone's Inc., and the said Marie Gauer Stone is the duly elected and acting Secretary of Stone's Inc.

That all of the shareholders of Stone's Inc., who are also all of the shareholders of said corporation entitled to vote on the affairs of the corporation, did, on the 31st day of March, 1960, at Nampa, Idaho, individually and unanimously give their written consent to the amendment of the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation so as to amend Article Fifth of the Articles of Incorporation. That a copy of the aforementioned written consent is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A", and is by reference thereto made a part hereof.

That the amendment is to the effect that Article Fifth of the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation is amended so that the same does read in its entirety as follows:

### "ARTICLE FIFTH

"All of the shares of this corporation are of the par value of \$100.00 each and the total authorized number of such par shares is 2,500 and their aggregate par value is \$250,000.00. All such shares are of the same class with equal rights and voting powers and without preference or priority of any share over any other, and are non-assessable."

That all other sections and provisions of the said Articles of Incorporation do remain in full force and effect.

## CONSENT TO AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
