ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be and is Snake River Lumber And Building Company, Limited.

ARTICLE II.

The objects for which this corporation shall be and is formed are as follows, to-wit:

- 1. To take over the existing lumber and building business now carried on by Harvey Romans, Edward T. Barber, Edward C. Barber, Jabez Saunders, and Robert S. Story, partners, under the firm name of Snake River Lumber and Building Company, in Minidoka, Idaho, together with all real estate, buildings, all properties within the confines of the buildings, all properties in transit or in any way connected with the business, all pending contracts not now completed and all stock in trade in connection with such pending contracts, and all materials, merchandise, goods, wares, and property of every class and description belonging to the said business.
- 2.. To buy, sell, deal in, at wholesale and retail, directly and indirectly, by and through the officers, stockholders, employees and a-

gents of this corporation, either for itself or on its own account, or as agent for others, any and all kinds of lumber, timber, builders hardware, building materials of every class and description, windmills, windmill fixtures, water pumps, and water pump fixtures.
