

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
SNAKE RIVER LUMBER AND BUILDING COMPANY, Limited.

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Know all men by these presents: That we,

Harvey Romans

Edward T. Barber

Emma C. Barber

Jabez Saunders

Robert S. Story

all of whom are citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby as the incorporators thereof certify as follows, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be and is Snake River Lumber And Building Company, Limited.

ARTICLE II.

The objects for which this corporation shall be and is formed are as follows, to-wit:

1. To take over the existing lumber and building business now carried on by Harvey Romans, Edward T. Barber, Emma C. Barber, Jabez Saunders, and Robert S. Story, partners, under the firm name of Snake River Lumber and Building Company, in Minidoka, Idaho, together with all real estate, buildings, all properties within the confines of the buildings, all properties without the confines of the buildings, all properties in transit or in any way connected with the business, all pending contracts not now completed and all stock in trade in connection with such pending contracts, and all materials, merchandise, goods, wares, and property of every class and description belonging to the said business.

2..To buy, sell,deal in, at wholesale and retail, directly and indirectly, by and through the officers, stockholders, employees and a-

gents of this corporation, either for itself or on its own account, or as agent for others, any and all kinds of lumber, timber, builders' hardware, building materials of every class and description, windmills, windmill fixtures, water pumps, ~~xxx~~ water pump fixtures. *Coal, and fencing material of all kinds.*

3. To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise from other persons or corporations, and to build, erect, construct, hold, own, possess, use, run, maintain and operate stores, depots, warehouses, office buildings and yards, with the necessary buildings, grounds, fixtures, appliances or equipment for use therein or in connection therewith for the purpose of purchasing, selling and dealing in any and all kinds of lumber, timber, builders' hardware, water pumps, fixtures for ~~xxxxx~~ water pumps, windmills, windmill fixtures and builders' material of every kind, class and description, *coal and fencing material of all kinds.*

4. To build, rebuild, erect, construct, improve, alter and repair for other persons or corporations any and all kinds of buildings, such as churches, hotels, inns, opera houses, saloons, residences, stores, halls, barns, offices, sheds, and any and all other kinds of structures or edifices of every class and description.

5. To do each and every act and thing whatsoever which may at any time be or become necessary, convenient or advisable for it to do in order to accomplish or carry out all or any of the objects or purposes or exercise all or any of the powers aforesaid; as well as each and every of the powers, expressly or impliedly conferred in or by the laws of the State of Idaho relating to the organization and management of private corporations formed thereunder.

6. To engage in any business hereinbefore mentioned, and to accomplish any of the purposes or objects hereinbefore specified, and to do and perform any of the acts or things hereinbefore set forth.

ARTICLE III.

The name of the place in which the main office and the principal place of ~~xxxx~~ business of this corporation shall be and is transacted is the Village of Albion, in the County of Cassia, in the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

The term for which said corporation shall and is to exist is fifty (50) years from this date.

ARTICLE V.

The number of Directors of this corporation shall be five, and the names and residences of those who are hereby appointed such Directors for the first year, that is to say until the 6th day of June, 1905, are as follows:

The amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be and is the sum of \$10,000, and the same shall be divided into 10,000 shares of the par value of \$1.00 per share.

The amount of said capital stock actually subscribed is one thousand (1,000) shares or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and the same has been subscribed by the persons and in the amounts below named.


