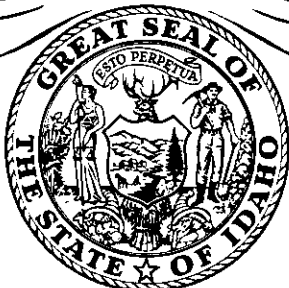

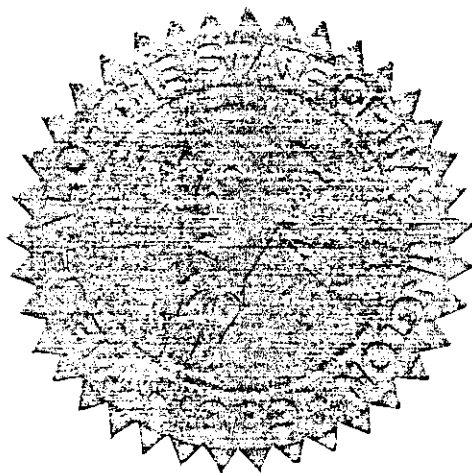

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ALL OF US, THE UNDERSIGNED, do hereby certify that the following is a true and correct copy of the articles of incorporation of the corporation named herein, as the same appear in the records of the State of Washington.

1. The name of this corporation shall be WASHINGTON ELECTRIC
LUMBER CO., INC.

2. The objects for which this corporation is formed are: to
engage in the business of physical and chemical testing of materials and sub-
stances of all kinds; to provide research and consulting services to others;
to manufacture and compound, sell and otherwise dispose of chemicals and other
products; to acquire, own, operate and dispose of real and personal property
of any kind, tangible or intangible, in any manner, to borrow money and to
pledge, mortgage or otherwise hypothecate its property as security for re-
payment thereof; to loan money; and generally to do any act or conduct any
business or enterprise not prohibited by law. It may carry on its business
and activity at wholesale or retail, within or without the State of Washington,
and either as principal or agent, and either alone or in association as
partner or joint adventurer with other persons or firms.

3. Its duration shall be perpetual.

4. The location and post office address of its registered office
in the State of Washington shall be E. 118 Brown Street, Spokane, Washington.

5. Its capitalization shall consist of par value shares in the
amount of five thousand (5000) of the par value of \$10.00 each.
