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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

RAINBOWS END ART LEAGUE , INC.

WE, the undersigned, being four natural persons of legal age and citizens of the United States, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a not-for-profit corporation, pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE I

 ${\underline{\sf NAME}}$: The name of the corporation shall be RAINBOWS END ART LEAGUE, ${\it INC}$

ARTICLE II

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purposes for which this corporation was organized are:

- To help develop and promote the arts, and artists, in southeast Idaho, and, as far as our influence may reach;
- 2) To increase the awareness and appreciation of the arts;
- To seek the highest standards in all activities of the art profession;
- 4) To provide a facility and environment wherein any friend and associate of the league will be encouraged and instructed in his artistic persuits - be they the newest of amateurs or the most accomplished of professionals;
- 5) To provide a means or vehicle of recognition and promotion for artists of exceptional ability and/or merit;

6) To engage in any activity or business which a corporation may determine as proper for the furtherance of the purposes herein mentioned and to have and acquire all powers authorized by the State of Idaho for not-for-profit corporations.

ARTICLE III

TERM OF EXISTENSE: This corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERSHIP: In lieu of capital stock, the association shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof which certificates cannot be assigned, except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as the by-laws may prescribe.

Each member in good standing under the by-laws of the corporation shall be entitled to one (1) vote at the meetings of the association.

ARTICLE VII

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS:

- 1) The method and manner of holding directors'
 meetings and association meetings, the authority
 and duties of each of the officers of the
 association and all other matters for management
 or control of the association shall be determined
 by the by-laws of the association and by the laws
 of the State of Idaho.
- 2) These articles of incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law and in conformity with I. C. 30-1006. Every amendment shall be approved by and proposed by the Board of Directors to the association members and approved by the association members by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members present at such meeting and providing that a quorum as specified under the laws of the State of Idaho is present.
