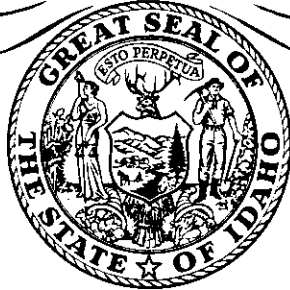

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that

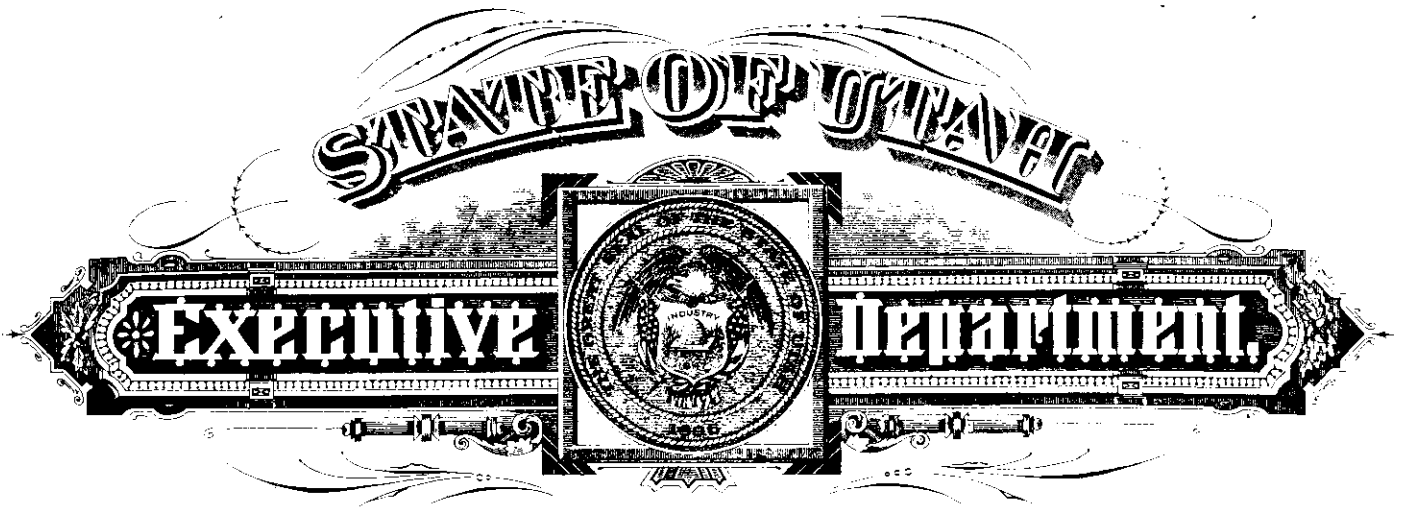
#### **ATLAS BUILDERS AND SUPPLY**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
ATLAS BUILDERS AND SUPPLY

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Utah Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is ATLAS BUILDERS AND SUPPLY.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To engage generally in the construction business, and to erect, alter, remodel and add to buildings of every class and description, and to contract for the erecting, decorating, remodeling, improving and furnishing thereof; To process, deal in, manufacture, install, store, handle, transport, or otherwise work in or with building materials of all kinds, including lumber, roofing, insulating materials, plaster, wall, tile, ornamental and other boards, brick, concrete, structural steel, re-enforcing steel, glass, stone, pottery, tile, lighting fixtures, hardware, plumbing supplies, electrical supplies, cements and plasters, stucco, stone and gravel, textiles, fencing, walls, water proofing materials, rubber, linoleums, carpets, builders' tools and machinery and any and every other material, appurtenance, or process useful in, necessary for, or convenient in building, construction, engineering, and maintenance; To purchase, build, erect construct, lease or otherwise acquire, manage, occupy, maintain, and operate buildings of any and all lawful kind; To act as a general contractor for the construction, repairing and remodeling of buildings and public works of all kinds, and for the improvement of real estate, and the doing of any and all other business and contracting incidental thereto, or connected therewith, and the doing and per-

forming of any and all acts or things necessary, proper, or convenient for or incidental to the furtherance or the carrying out of the powers or purposes herein mentioned; To engage in the general speculative home building business; To purchase, own, hold and sell real property, improved and unimproved, or any interest therein or easement thereon; To loan money upon real property and to accept secured and unsecured notes as collateral for same; To execute notes, deeds of trust, mortgages, chattel mortgages; To enter into leases as landlord or tenant; To Perform or do any act customarily performed or done by a general contractor and builder; To invest in and hold for investment any and all real property, shares of stock, bonds, government, private or corporate; To exchange of one parcel of real property for another parcel or real property or any other lawful consideration; to finance the purchase, improvement, development, and construction of land and buildings belonging to or to be acquired by this Company, or any other person, firm, or corporation; To manufacture purchase or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and transfer, or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and with goods, wares, and merchandise and real and personal property of every class and description; To engage in any commercial and industrial enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation and in conformity with the laws of the State of Utah; To generally engage in, do, and perform, any enterprise, act, or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is: Four Thousand Five Hundred (4,500) shares of Class "A" common stock at par value of One Dollar (\$1.00). There shall be no cumulative voting, and each share shall entitle the holder thereof to one vote at all meetings of stockholders upon each mattersubmitted to a vote at a meeting of shareholders. The private property of the stockholders shall not be liable for the obligations of the corporation.

FIFTH: The corporation shall not commence business until at least Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) has been received by it as consideration for the issuance of shares.

SIXTH: The principal place of business of the corporation is 2220 South Second West, Salt Lake City, Utah, but the corporation may maintain an office in such towns, cities and places as the board of directors may determine.

SEVENTH: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are NONE.

EIGHTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 2805 South State Street, Salt Lake City, Utah, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is George H. Searle.

NINTH: The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is four (4), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:
