ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
INTERMOUNTAIN SOAP & CHEMICAL COMPANY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, all being citizens of the United States of America, this day having voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation shall be INTERMOUNTAIN SOAP & CHEMICAL COMPANY, INC.

ARTICLE II

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

(a). To enter into the operation of a retail and wholesale soap and chemical company engaged in the manufacture and fabrication of soaps, cleaning chemicals, floor waxes, cleaning materials, chemicals and articles of allied equipment of all kinds and types; the buying, selling and trading of same on a commission or other basis of compensation.

(b). To buy, sell and deal in all kinds of manufactured chemical goods, products and merchandise, and to transact all other allied business necessary or convenient in connection with the soap, detergent, floor wax and chemical business, both retail and wholesale.

(c). To buy, sell, lease, or exchange real or personal property of every kind and nature and to mortgage the same from time to time.

(d). To borrow and to loan money upon either real or personal property; to become a mortgagor or mortgagee thereof, and to take and give assignments thereof.

(1).

(e). To buy, sell, trade, or otherwise negotiate, stocks, bonds, mortgages, and all other negotiable instruments of whatsoever kind and character.

(f). To do everything or things herein set forth to the same extent as fully as natural persons might do or could do in the State of Idaho, or in any state, country or place.

(g). To have offices, conduct its business and promote its objects within and without the State of Idaho, without restriction as to place or amount; and this corporation shall have the power to hold meetings within or without the State of Idaho as may be determined from time to time by its By-laws.

(h). In general, but in connection with the foregoing, said corporation shall have and exercise all of the powers conveyed by the State of Idaho upon business corporations, it being expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of special powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner such general powers.

ARTICLE III

Duration

The period of existence and duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

Place of Business

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho, shall be Nampa, Canyon County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V

Stock

This corporation is authorized to issue one class of shares of capital stock and shall be designated as common stock.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be One Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars, to be divided into 1000 shares.

The par value of each of the shares of common stock shall be \$100.00.

ARTICLE VI

The capital stock of this corporation shall be non-assessable and the private property of the shareholders in this corporation shall not be liable for the debts, obligations and liabilities of this corporation.
