in said Kootenai County, as the authorized Agent of said
Corporation in said State of Idaho, upon whom process issued by authority of, or
under any law of the State of Idaho, may be served as provided by Article XI, Sec-
tion 10, of the Constitution of said State of Idaho.

And the said Spokane Mill Company
desiring and intending to conform in all respects to the Constitution and laws of
said State, does hereby accept the provisions of the Constitution of the State of
Idaho for all the intents and purposes contemplated by the provisions thereof, re-
lating to such acceptance, by other than municipal corporations. (Article XI,
Section 7.)
