ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THESE PRESENTS WITNESSETH:

That we, Chester S. Farquharson, Ruth A. Farquharson,
and Roy A. Bennett, being desirous of forming a corporation for
the purposes hereinafter provided, and in conformity to the laws
of the State of Washington, do make and subscribe the following
Articles of Incorporation in triplicate:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be,

ELITE SHADE & LINOLEUM COMPANY,

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed is and
shall be to buy, sell and otherwise dispose of furniture, fixtures,
mats, rugs, carpets and linoleum, and any and all kinds of the
same, and to sell any and all goods or materials used therein, or
any of them; to deal in linoleums, rattans and all products there-
of; to purchase, sell or control patents and to acquire and own
licenses under patents or patent rights, and to grant license or
licenses to other person or persons, corporation or corporations;
to manufacture and sell said patented articles or appliances or ma-
chinery under any or all patents or licenses which it may own or
have any interest in, or may hereafter acquire, and also to buy and
sell patents or patent rights of any material or kind, and to grant
licenses thereunder, and to do any and all other business which is
lawful and not contrary to the laws of the State of Washington; and
to establish agencies or branches in any and all places it may see
fit, and to do any and all lawful business incidental to or in any

way connected with said purposes, or any of them; to buy, sell, deal in and produce window shades, wall papers, wall hangings, and all other coverings and products and preparations thereof, and for the purposes aforesaid, to act as agent and broker in the sale thereof; to make contracts and business arrangements to that end, and in order to perfect the same, to purchase or lease or otherwise take and hold real estate and personal estate, erect buildings, warehouses, machinery, plants and apparatus necessary for the manufacture and sale of such articles, and for the doing of all lawful acts, deeds and things necessary for the effectual carrying out of the true intent and meaning of this corporation and the business intended to be carried on by it.

ARTICLE III.

The time of existence of this corporation shall be fifty (50) years.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and post office address of its registered office in this state is 4411 Wallingford Avenue, Seattle, Washington.

ARTICLE V.

That the total amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be ten thousand (10,000) shares, of the par value of One (\$1.00) Dollar per share.

ARTICLE VI.

There are no restrictions or privileges granted or imposed upon the common stock of this corporation, and each share shall have one vote. The amount of paid-in capital with which the said corporation will begin business is Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE VII.

The number of trustees of this corporation shall be

three (3), and the names and residences of the trustees who shall manage the concerns of the corporation until the 7th day of January, 1941, and the number of shares subscribed by each, are as follows:
