## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

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CONSUMER'S COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESES FRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, the president and

secretary respectively of the Consumer's Cooperative Association Inc., do

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hereby certify as follows: That Consumer's Cooperative Association, Inc., is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho.

That at a special meeting of the Board of Directors of said Consumer's Cooperative Association, Inc., was duly held on the 29th day of January, 1959, at the office of the corporation in the city of Weiser, County of Washington, State of Idaho, at which meeting a quorum of the Board of Director of said corporation was present; that at said meeting the following Resolution was regularly proposed, voted upon and adopted by a two/thirds (2/3) vote of all the Directors of said corporation amending the Articles of Incorporation; that the following is a full, true and complete copy of said Resolution of said Board of Directors amending the Articles of Incorporation;

"Resolved that the Articles of Incorporation of the Consumer's Cooperative Association, Inc. be amended by amending Article V as previoually amended so that it shall as amended read as follows, to-wit:

#### ARTICLE V.

That the total capitalization of this Association shall be two hundred thousand (\$200,000.00) Dollars and shall be divided as follows, to-wit: One thousand (1,000% shares of common stock at a par value of one hundred (100.00) dollars for each share; the common stock only shall have a voting right.

(1,000)One thousand/shares of preferred stock at a par value of one hundred (\$100.60) dollars for each share; said preferred stock shall have no voting rights and shall bear interest at a rate of not more than eight per cent per annum, provided, however, that the rate of interest on said preferred stock may be increased by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the holders of common stock present at any annual meeting.

That each member of the Association may elect to pay for his share of Common Stock in cash or he may let his earnings be applied to his share in the Association the earings for the year 1945 and subsequent years to be set up for this purpose."

That thereafter at the regular annual meeting of the members of said corporation subsequent to due and proper notice, was duly held at the place specified in said notice in the city of Weiser, County of Washington, State of Idaho on the 3rd day of February, 1959; that a quorum of the members of said corporation were present; that at said meeting a Resolution approving the action of the Board of Directors at their meeting on the 29th day of January, 1959, amending ARTICLE V of the Articles of Incorporation was regularly proposed, voted upon and adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members present at such meeting; that the following is a full, true and correct copy of the Resolution of said members approving the action of the Board of Directors:

"On this, the 3rd day of February, 1959, at the regular annual meeting of the members of the Consumer's Cooperative Association, Inc., a quorum of the members being present there was presented a Resolution of the Board of Directors of said Association dated the 29th day of January, 1959m for the amendment of the Articles of Incorporation by amending Article V, as previously amended, so that it shall as amended read as follows, to-wit:

### ARTICLE V.

That the total capitalization of this Association shall be two hundred thousand (\$200,000.00) Dollars and shall be divided as follows, to-wit: One thousand (1,000) shares of common stock at a par value of one hundred (100.00) dollars for each share; the common stock only shall have a voting right.

One thousand (1,000) shares of preferred stock at a par value of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each share; said preferred stock shall have no voting rights and shall bear interest at a rate of not more than eight per cent per annum, provided, however, that the rate of interest on said preferred stock may be increased by the affirmative vote of two thirds (2/3) of the holders of common stock present at any annual meeting.

That each member of the Association may elect to pay for his share of Common Stock in cash or he may let his earnings be applied to his share in
