ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
SCENIC BAY YACHT CLUB, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned  
FRED H. BLOOD, GERALD M. CROWE, DEAN A. SEMMEN, BYRON W. BEEMAN,  
and JOHN M. GRAY, persons of the age of twenty-one (21) years, or  
more, hereby acting as incorporators to voluntarily associate  
themselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cor-  
poration under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to that end  
we do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is SCENIC BAY YACHT CLUB,  
INC.

ARTICLE II

That the period of duration of the corporation is per-  
petual.

ARTICLE III

That the nature of the business, and the objects and  
purposes to be transacted, promoted and carried on are to do any  
and all things hereinafter mentioned as fully and to the same  
extent as natural persons might or could do, to-wit:

(A) To further the enjoyment of boating, to promote  
fellowship among boaters, and to work toward safer boating.

(B) To purchase, own, hold, lease, sell, exchange or  
otherwise transfer personal property of every class and descrip-  
tion.

(C) To purchase, acquire, own, hold, lease, sell and

exchange real property.

(D) To do any and all such other acts, things, business or in any other matter those things incidental, convenient, auxiliary or necessary to any of the objectives hereinbefore enumerated.

(E) To enter into and make, perform and carry out all types of contracts relative to furthering the enjoyment of boating by corporation members and to work toward safer boating.

#### ARTICLE IV

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be Box 125, Bayview, Kootenai County, Idaho.

#### ARTICLE V

This non-profit corporation shall be organized with certificates of membership. A certificate of membership shall be called a "Plank Membership Certificate." Plank membership certificates shall be held, sold and paid for at such time and in such manner as by-laws may from time to time direct.

#### ARTICLE VI

A plank membership certificate is issued to members who are called "plank members." A plank member must be a legal adult individual who has made application and is accepted as per the procedure adopted in the corporate by-laws. All plank memberships are equal and no member shall have more rights or privileges than any other member.

#### ARTICLE VII

The board of directors shall consist of all the elected officers and the immediate past commodore, and shall be called the "Board of Officers." The board of officers shall be the managing and governing body of the corporation. The board of officers

and all other officers shall serve without compensation.
