ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
COOLIN CIVIC
ORGANIZATION, INCORPORATED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT We, the undersigned citizens of the United States and of the State of Idaho, being of full legal age, have this day associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, (Idaho Code, Sec. 30-1001), with the rights, powers and privileges incident thereto and for such purposes enter into and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation is Coolin Civic Organization, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II

The objects and purposes for which this Corporation is organized are as follows:

(a.) To sponsor, participate in, assist, operate, manage and perform all other acts necessary or incident to and improving the community of Coolin and Bonner County, Idaho, and to assist other civic organizations, youth organizations, Religious organizations, and community minded persons.

(b.) To own real and personal property and to enter into leases and agreements and to buy, sell and convey and acquire the same.

(c.) To contract debts, issue Notes and other evidences of indebtedness.

(d.) To enter into any and all contracts, agreements and franchises that may become necessary to carry out the purposes aforesaid, with any municipal corporation, body, group or individual.

ARTICLE III

The principle place of business of this Corporation shall be at Coolin, in Bonner County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

The period of existence of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

The government and business affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors of not less than five (5) members. Said Board of Directors shall be elected at such times and for such periods as may be fixed by the by-laws of this organization.

ARTICLE VI

This Corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE VII

The membership of this Corporation shall consist of persons, clubs, associations and all organized bodies and groups as may from time to time pay the required membership fee as the same may be set by the Board of Directors in compliance with the by-laws hereafter adopted. A certificate of membership shall be issued to each member hereof, which certificate cannot be assigned except on such terms and conditions as may be set forth under the by-laws of this Corporation. The by-laws of this Corporation shall provide the qualification of membership and the terms and conditions of admission.

ARTICLE VIII

No member shall have or acquire any right, title or interest in any of the earnings or accumulations of this Corporation or its property. The right and interests of all members shall be equal and each shall have equal voice and right at all meetings of members and the right to equal privileges upon payment
