OF THE
YOUNG MEN'S CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION OF BOISE CITY, IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation, under the laws of the state of Idaho.

And we hereby certify: First, That the name of said corporation is The Young Men's Christian Association of Boise City, Idaho.

Second; That the purposes for which it is founded are to promote the spiritual, intellectual, social and physiaal welfare of young men.

Third; That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be Boise City, Idaho.

Fourth; That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth; That the number of its directors shall be five, and that the names and residences of those who were elected for the first year are as set forth in the following certificate.

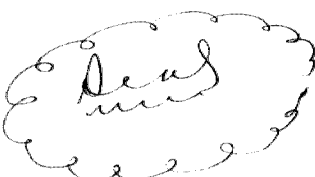

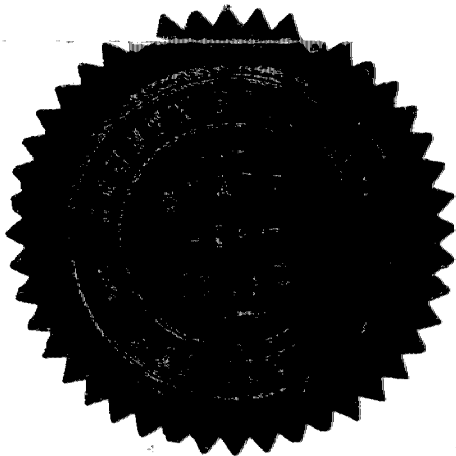
