The undersigned person, acting as the incorporator and desiring to form a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, Idaho Code § 30-29-101 et. seq., adopts the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE 1. Name. The name of the corporation is CX Holdings Inc.

ARTICLE 2. Shares. The corporation is authorized to issue 1,000,000 shares, all of one class.

ARTICLE 3. Registered Office and Registered Agent. The address of the corporation's initial registered office in the state of Idaho is 1034 Kimball Lane, Bancroft, Idaho 83217. The name of the corporation's initial registered agent at such address is Craig C. Crandall.

ARTICLE 4. Incorporator. The name and address of the incorporator are Crandall Farms, Inc., a Utah corporation, 1034 South Main Street, Springville, Utah 84663.

ARTICLE 5. Limitation on Liability of Directors. No director of the corporation shall be personally liable to the corporation or its shareholders for money damages for any action taken, or any failure to take any action, as a director, except liability for: (i) the amount of a financial benefit received by a director to which the director is not entitled; (ii) an intentional infliction of harm on the corporation or the shareholders; (iii) a violation of Idaho Code § 30-29-832; or (iv) an intentional violation of criminal law.

ARTICLE 6. Indemnification of Directors. The corporation shall indemnify each and every director for liability, as defined in Idaho Code § 30-29-850(3), to any person for any action taken, or any failure to take any action, as a director, except liability for: (i) receipt of a financial benefit to which the director is not entitled; (ii) an intentional infliction of harm on the corporation or its shareholders; (iii) a violation of Idaho Code § 30-29-832; or (iv) an intentional violation of criminal law.
