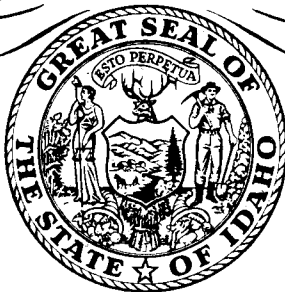

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

WHITE BIRD COMMUNITY METHODIST CHURCH, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Thirtieth** day of **April** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-five** and ~~as~~ ^{will be} duly recorded on ~~Film No.~~ ^{microfilm} of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **White Bird** in the County of **Idaho** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

WHITE BIRD COMMUNITY METHODIST CHURCH, INC.

We, the undersigned persons residing in Idaho County, State of Idaho, all being deeply interested in the religious, spiritual, moral and intellectual welfare and development of the community in which we reside, and being desirous of organizing and establishing a church in conformity to the rules, usages and Discipline of The Methodist Church, and being desirous of forming a corporation pursuant to the statutes of the State of Idaho governing the formation of corporations for education, religious, social and charitable purposes or objects, do hereby associate ourselves together as a corporation, and do adopt the following as and for the Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be WHITE BIRD COMMUNITY METHODIST CHURCH, INC., and its location and principal place of business shall be White Bird, County of Idaho, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE II

OBJECTS OR PURPOSES

A. The corporation shall support the Doctrine, and it, and all its property, both real and personal, shall be subject to the laws, usages, and ministerial appointments of The Methodist Church as are now or shall be from time to time established, made and declared by the lawful authority of the said Church.

B. The corporation shall have the power to acquire and hold title in fee simple, in trust, or otherwise, to both real and personal property, and to improve, incumber, sell, convey, and dispose of all such

property in conformity with the Discipline of The Methodist Church. The corporation shall have the further right to obtain credit by any lawful means to carry out the objects of the corporation, all in conformity to said Discipline.

C. Subject to the provisions of the Discipline, the corporation shall have the power to erect and maintain buildings for the worship of God, for training in Christian faith and conduct, and for Christian social intercourse, and to acquire or build and maintain residences for the use and occupancy of its ministers.

D. To beautify and improve the property of the said corporation by the construction of playgrounds, landscaping, parking facilities, and other improvements in conformity with the general purposes of the organization and the welfare of its members and community.

E. To engage in all forms of religious, missionary, social and charitable work or endeavor, and in general promote, spread, and establish the Christian gospel, and to furnish and provide training and instruction for the youth of the community.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

This corporation shall be a non-profit organization and its membership shall be open to all persons who desire to live a Christian life and who subscribe to the By-Laws of this corporation and the general laws, Doctrine and Discipline of The Methodist Church, and assume the vows thereof provided they are at least eighteen (18) years of age.

ARTICLE IV

OFFICERS

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall be the Board of Trustees of the local church, elected and organized as prescribed in the Discipline of The Methodist Church. The Board shall consist of not fewer than three (3) nor more than nine (9) persons, each of whom

shall be not less than twenty-one (21) years of age, and at least two-thirds (2/3) of whom shall be members of The Methodist Church. The Trustees shall be amenable to the quarterly conference of said Church, and shall be divided into three (3) classes, to serve until their successors are elected. The first Board of Trustees shall consist of:

Said Trustees were elected on the 25 day of April, 1965, at White Bird, Idaho, by a majority of the members then present.

Notice of said election was given, as required by law, by publishing the same in Idaho County Free Press Grangeville, Idaho, and by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where the election was to be held, at least two (2) weeks prior to said election.

ARTICLE V

INCORPORATORS

The incorporators herein are of full legal age and citizens of the United States, and notice of the intention to incorporate was given, as required by law, by publishing the same in Idaho County Free Press, in Grangeville, Idaho, and by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where the election was to be held, at least two (2) weeks prior to said election.

ARTICLE VI

BY-LAWS

The corporation shall adopt By-Laws from time to time which shall govern the conduct of the officers and the duties of the members. The By-Laws of the corporation shall be in conformity with the laws of the State of Idaho, and shall include the Discipline of The Methodist Church as from time to time enacted, authorized and declared by the General Conference and no other by-laws shall be adopted inconsistent with the provisions of the Discipline.

ARTICLE VII

DURATION

This corporation shall be perpetual. If, for any reason, the corporation shall cease to exist as a legal entity and its charter shall expire or be terminated, then the title to all its property, both real and personal, shall be vested in the Pacific Northwest Annual Conference of the Methodist Church; and all such property shall be held in trust for the benefit of the local church.

The foregoing Articles were executed in triplicate and adopted as the Articles of Incorporation of White Bird Community Methodist Church, Inc., at White Bird, Idaho, by the undersigned incorporators this 28 day of April, 1965.
