ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

RED COLLAR STRAMBOAT COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, the undersigned, FRED HERRICK of St. Maries, Benewah County, State of Idaho, and E. W. ELLER and C. H. POTTS of Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, State of Idaho, all of whom are citizens of the United States of America, and bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho,

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

First.

That the name of said corporation shall be, "RED COLLAR STEAMBOAT COMPANY."

Second.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are to conduct and carry on a general transportation business; to buy, acquire, own, build, construct, improve, lease and control steamboats, barges and river and lake craft of every kind and description: to operate such steamboats, barges and other craft for the transportation of freight and passengers; to purchase, own, build, construct, maintain and operate plants and works for the building and repair of steamboats, barges and other craft; to transport freight and passengers for hire by rail or water in any manner; to conduct and carry on the business of dredging, pile-driving and diking, and to engage in a general construction and contracting business; to acquire and use such franchises and enjoy such other rights and privileges as may be necessary or desirable to the conduct of its business; to buy, sell, lease and build houses, structures, vessels, wharves, docks, piers, bridges and any other improvements, machinery, equipment, appliances and other property, necessary or convenient for the conduct of the business in which it

shall be engaged; to engage in the business of handling and transporting logs by rail or water, and for such purpose to acquire by purchase, condemnation or otherwise, and hold, use and own such real or personal property or estate as may be necessary for the purpose of catching, booming, sorting, rafting, hauling and transporting logs, lumber or other timber products; to tow barges, rafts, booms, logs, timber products, and allother kinds of personal property; to buy, sell, lease, conduct, control and operate mercantile establishments, restaurants, eating-houses, stores and warehouses of every kind, and to transact a general merchandise and warehouse business: to acquire, hold, sell, assign and transfer shares of stock in other corporations when authorized by law, and to exercise all the privileges of ownership, including voting the stock so held: to buy, sell, lease, own, hold, control, mortgage or take mortgages upon real estate and personal property; to improve the navigation of rivers, streams, lakes and other bodies of water; to borrow money, make and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds, debentures and evidence of indebtedness of all kinds, whether or not secured by mortgage or pledge or otherwise, without limit as to amount, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge or otherwise: to enter into and carry out contracts of every kind pertaining to its business or the purposes for which it is formed; to purchase, acquire and hold real estate and personal property, and lease, rent, sell, convey and otherwise dispose of the same; to exercise the right of eminent domain when and where deemed necessary and proper, and permitted by the laws of the State of Idaho, or such other states, territories or countries where this corporation may be authorized to do business; and generally to do each and every act and thing necessary or proper to be done in or about the objects and purposes herein expressed, or incidental to such objects and purposes.

Third.

That the place where the principal business of said

corporation is to be transacted is the City of Coeur d'Alene, in the County of Kootenai, State of Idaho.

Fourth.

That the term for which said corporation is to exist shall be Fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation, unless sooner dissolved and disincorporated according to law. and the number of its Directors shall be three.

Fifth.

That the amount of the capital stock of said corporation is Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$250,000) Dollars, and the number of shares into which it is divided is Twenty-five Hundred (2500) shares of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per share.

Sixth.
