In the matter of the application by petition of Harry L. Cannon and others for the Incorporation of the Village of Ashton, the Board finds the following to be the facts:

First.

That the Territory to be embraced within the limits of said incorporated Village is described as follows:

North half of the North west quarter; North west quarter of north east quarter of Section 36, and South west quarter of South east quarter and South west quarter of Section Twenty five all in Township Nine North of Range forty two East of Boise Meridian.

Ashton Incorporated

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Second.

That there are residing within the limits above described more than 200 bona fide residents

Third.

That a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the above described Territory have signed the petition for such incorporation.

Fourth

That the name they wish to assume is "Village of Ashton".

We therefore declare the above described Territory incorporated the Village of Ashton, and this order of Incorporation shall be spread upon the Commissioners Minutes, and we appoint the Commissioners Minutis, and we appoint to L Cannon, H G Fuller, Jonas Mosser, Joseph Murphy and O B Ricks (each being over 21 years of age, a tax payer, and each an inhabitant of said Village) Trustees of said Village who shall hold their office, and perform the duties thereof, until the lawful election and qualification of their successors.

On petition of C. J. Kirklin and 12 other citizens and tax payers of Fremont County, and provided there is no expense to the County in the opening thereof, it is hereby ordered that a County Road be established on the following lines.

Road

Beginning at a point on the public road between sections 14 and 23 Twp 9 N. R 44 E. B. M. and running East between sections 13 and 24 of same Township and Range and still East between sections 18 and 19, 17 and 20, 16 and 21, 15 and 22 of Twp 9 N. R 44 E. B. M. and extending to the Bluff on the west bank of Porcupine Creek.

The resignation of Geo B Edie Overseer of Medicine Lodge District is hereby accepted and on petition of J. A. Pyke and others O. C. Darch is appointed in his place

The resignation of W. W. Caldwell as Justice of the Peace of Dubois Precinct is hereby accepted.

The resignation of L. B. Waterman as Justice of the Peace of Leigh Precinct is hereby accepted.
