ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, Jay Combs, being of lawful age, acting as incorporator under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article I

The name of the corporation is YMC, INC.

Article II

The period of duration is perpetual.

Article III

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to own and operate a mechanical contracting company for the purpose of installing mechanical installations in buildings and the transaction of any and all other lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

Article IV

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is one hundred thousand (100,000) shares of common stock, all of the same class, each having no par value.

Article V

The corporation shall elect to be taxed as a Subchapter S Corporation under the Internal Revenue Code.

The corporation shall only authorize and issue one class of stock (voting common).

No Stockholder shall do any act (including the sale or transfer of such Stockholder's stock) which shall contravene or revoke the corporation's election to be taxed as a Subchapter S Corporation.

Article VI

Provisions denying preemptive rights are: shareholders shall have no preemptive right to unissued or treasury stock.

Article VII

Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are: none.

Article VIII

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 4414 S. Gekeler Lane, Boise, Idaho 83705, and the name of it's registered agent at such address is RONALD C. YANKE.

Article IX

The numbers of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the Corporation is two (2). The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and qualify are as follows:
