ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

BIBLE MISSIONARY UNION OF COUNTY OF CANYON STATE OF IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, having associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a religious corporation under and by virture of the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

Τ.

That the name of the corporation is and shall be: BIBLE MISSIGNARY UNION OF COUNTY OF CANYON, STATE OF IDAHO, INC.

II.

The duration of this corporation is from October 5. 1955 and is to have perpetual existence.

III.

The location and principal place of business of this corporation shall be lamps in the County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

IV.

The purpose for which said corporation is organized and incorporated is and shall be:

- (1) To establish and maintain a place of Divine Worship.
- (2) The study and practice of Godliness as set forth in the Sacred Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments.
- (3) The exercise of a spiritual watch care over each other, on the part of the membership and a building one and another up in the Christian Faith.

- (4) To carry out the great commission of our Lord in preaching and publishing the gospel to the people of its ministry, to be accomplished by establishing and promoting Sunday Schools, missions and all other means deemed practical.
- (5) Said Union shall have authority to ordain ministers to the full work of the ministry and to issue credentials to all ordained ministers authorizing them to do and perform all duties commonly connected with their offices as ministers.
- (6) The Union shall have authority to issue or refuse to issue credentials based upon Christian character, and ability to qualify after proper investigation, said credentials to be issued by the Secretary of the Association upon receipt of a proper application and approval thereof by officers of the association, and shall become effective when signed by the chairman and secretary.
- (7) To purchase, lease, acquire, accept, hold and manage by deed, grant, will, gift, bequest, trust or otherwise all manner and kinds of property whether real, personal or mixed to be used for and carry out the purposes for which said corporation was organized.
- (8) To borrow, sell, mortage, issue its notes, bonds, debentures and other evidences of indebtedness and to do any and every act or thing germane to any of the afore-said purposes.
- (9) Pecuniary profit shall not be the object or purpose of this corporation.

VI.

The estimated value of the property and money possessed by this corporation at the time of executing these articles of incorporation within the State of Idaho and vested in said corporation is Fourteen Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty Bollars (\$14,360.00). The sources of revenue or income of this corporation is and will be pledges, gifts, bequests, offerings, contributions and money derived from the property of the corporation.

VII.

Two publication were made of notice of incorporation and election of directors (also known as trustees) of Bible Missionary Union of County Of Canyon, State of Idaho, Said notices were placed in the Idaho Free Press, newspaper of general circulation for Nampa, county of Canyon, Idaho, on the twenty-fourth day of Sept.,1955 and on the first day of Oct., 1955 two weeks prior to the scheduled meeting of its members, by said newspaper, the Idaho Free Press.
