KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation, under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and to that effect do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of this corporation shall be the
Alamo Colony Company, Limited.

ARTICLE II.

That the purposes for which it is formed are, to buy, hold, sell, dispose of, deliver, handle, deal in, make, mould, dry, burn press and manufacture bricks; to buy, hold, sell, dispose of, deliver, handle, deal in, make and manufacture lime and cement; to buy hold, sell, dispose of, transfer, convey, use, rent, lease, run, maintain, and operate quarries of any and every kind and description; to buy, hold, sell, mortgage, hypothecate, trade and contract for, real estate and any and every interest therein, and to lease, demise, transfer, assign and convey the same or any portion thereof; to build dwellings, barns, store-rooms, or other buildings or improvements thereat and thereon; to loan money and take and receive promissory notes mortgages, bonds, contracts or other securities or evidences of indebtedness; to buy discount trade, and contract for accounts, promissory notes, mortgages, bonds contracts and other securities and evidences of indebtedness; to borrow and make and execute and deliver therefor promissory notes, mortgages, bonds, contracts and other proper and necessary evidence thereof and obligations therefor; to erect, construct, maintain repair, rent lease, sell, transfer, superintend and control houses, dwellings, store-rooms and other buildings, for itself and other persons and corporations, in property, securities and evidences of indebtedness, and look after, manage, attend to and control the same; to erect construct, maintain, equip, operate, control, superintend and manage water works, and systems of waterworks and other means of furnishing, distributing and supplying water for the use of towns, cities, houses, dwellings, store-rooms, and other buildings, live stock, irrigation, watering and sprinkling yards, lawns, grass, cereals, farms and garden produce, and other peices and parcels of land, and for all other lawful purposes; to build, erect construct, equip, maintain, manage, control and operate railroad and steamboat lines and other means of transportation for freight and passengers to and from diverse and sundry points, within the State of *Idaho* and *Kanlim co*, and to receive, charge, and collect compensation therefor; To purchase, construct, erect, build, equip, maintain, operate, sell, transfer and convey, and, in proper manner, let, demise, lease, hire and dispose of stock yards and appurtenances, freight yards and switches, side tracks, freight and passenger depots, elevators and warehouses, terminal facilities, wharves and docks for railroads staemboats and other means of transportation, and to charge, receive and collect compensation for the use and occupation thereof and for services rendered in connection therewith; to purchase, lay out, dedicate, establish, develop, improve, bargain, sell, mortgage, hypothecate,

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contract for, transfer, convey and deal in townsites and portions thereof, and additions thereto, grade streets and otherwise improve the same, or any portions thereof; to purchase, buy, sell, acquire, hold, transfer, convey, construct, erect, build, equip, manage, control, maintain and operate street railways and systems of street railways, electric lights, electric light plants or systems, power, plants and stations, gas, works, gas plants and appurtenances, with full power and authority to secure, procure, buy, purchase, contract for, sell, transfer, assign, convey, and mortgage franchises for each and all of said matters and things; to use, purchase, sell, develop, improve, create, make, generate, furnish conduct, distribute and maintain steam, water and electric power and plants and other power, and charge, receive and collect compensation therefor; to erect construct, equip, buy, sell, assign, transfer, convey, control, manage maintain and operate telephones and telephone lines, exchanges and systems within the State of *Idaho* and *Kootenai Co*; to buy, hold, sell, dispose of, contract for, sell, assign, and transfer merchandise of any and all kinds and descriptions, and to do a general merchandising retail and wholesale business or either of them, and trade and traffic therein and therewith; to buy, hold, sell, dispose of, deliver deal in, handle, make and manufacture sewer pipe, tile, tiling, terra cotta, cement, stone and all clay molds and products of every kind, nature and description; to buy, hold, deliver, deal in, handle, sell dispose of, make and manufacture boxes, packing cases, shingles, laths and lumber and wood products of every kind nature and description; to buy, hold, sell, dispose of, handle deliver, make and manufacture barrels, casks, buckets and all other cooperage articles and things of every kind nature and description; to buy, hold sell, dispose of, deliver, handle, deal in, make prepare and manufacture powder and any and all other explosives of whatsoever kind, nature and description; and to do generally all business matters and things in connection with the purposes, matters and things above described and enumerated, or that may be necessary or proper for the complete enjoyment, use and benefit thereof.

ARTICLE III.

That the principal place of business of this corporation shall be at the home of the Alamo Colony Company, in Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Sixty-three (63) Range one (1) West of Boise meridian in Kootenai County, Idaho, and the present post office address is Bonners Ferry, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

The term for which this corporation shall exist is Fifty years from and after the date of filing these articles, unless sooner legally dissolved.

ARTICLE V.

The Board of Directors for this corporation shall consist of five stockholders.

ARTICLE VI.
