

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
THE PARROTT CIGAR STORE, LIMITED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:- That we, the undersigned, having this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, HEREBY CERTIFY:-

ARTICLE I .

That the name of this corporation is THE PARROTT CIGAR STORE, LIMITED.

ARTICLE II .

That the purposes for which it is formed is to engage in and carry on, in Boise, Idaho, and elsewhere, the business of manufacturing and dealing in Cigars, Tobacco, Smoker's and Tobacconist's supplies, at wholesale and retail: to manufacture, buy, sell, import, export, and generally deal in pipes, cigar and cigarette holders, smoker's and tobacco dealer's supplies of all kinds: to manufacture, buy, sell, lease or otherwise acquire machinery, tools, implements and appliances incidental to and necessary in the handling, and treatment of leaf tobacco or in the manufacture of cigars, cigarettes, cheroots, chewing and smoking tobacco, smoker's and tobacconist's supplies; to build, operate, maintain, lease or otherwise acquire factories, warehouses, buildings and stores suitable for the care, handling, storing, preparation, manufacture and sale of tobacco and its several products, and of smoker's and tobacconist's supplies:

ARTICLE III.

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted is Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from the date of said incorporation.

ARTICLE V .

That the number of its directors is four and the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are:-

That the amount of the CAPITAL STOCK of said corporation is TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND dollars, and the number of shares into which it is divided is TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY, of the par value of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS, each.

That the amount of the CAPITAL STOCK actually subscribed is TWELVE THOUSAND dollars, and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed, and the amount subscribed by each of them, to-wit:-
