ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

know ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; That we, the undersigned, do hereby certify that we have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of Title 30 Chapterll, Idaho Code, in manner following, to-wit:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be "CHRIST'S GOSPEL MISSION, INC."

ARTICLE II

This corporation is not organized for the pecuniary profit of its directors, officers, or members; nor may it issue stock nor declare nor distribute dividends, and not part of its net income shall inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member; and any balance of money or assets remaining after the full payment of corporate obligations of all kinds shall be devoted solely to the charitable, educational, religious, and benevolent purposes of the corporation.

ARTICLE III

The purposes of this corporation shall be: to provide for the worship of God, the teaching and preaching of the Word of God, the winning of people to a personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and in the spiritual improvement of mankind, to advance the interests of the above named mission in Boise, Idahe and surrounding area, and to extend the ministry of the Gospel unto all the earth, and to that end the corporation shall have the power and authority to acquire, hold, rent, sell, and dispose of, convey, lease, and mortgage any real or personal property; and the said corporation shall have power and authority

to borrow money to further its objects and shall nave power generally to carry out the objects and purposes for which it is organized, or any of the objects herein, or are, or will be, granted to such a corporation by the laws of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

The principal and registered office of transacting business for this corporation is Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

That hereafter Five (5) persons of lawful age, to be elected as provided in the By-Laws, shall constitute the number of trustees who shall be ex-officie directors of the corporation .

ARTICLE VI

The authorized number and qualifications of members of this corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the voting and other rights and privileges of members shall be set forth in the By-laws adopted.

ARTICLE VII

The management and title of all property of this corporation, real, personal and mixed, shall be under the control of the Board of Directors; that the election and the duties of the Directors shall be specified in the By-laws; That this corporation shall exist perpetually hereafter.

ARTICLE VIII

The promotion, operation, and maintenance of the Mission shall be under the control and supervision of said Board of Directors elected in the manner provided in the By-laws adopted.

ARTICLE IX

The By-laws of this corporation shall be adopted by the Directors named in the Articles of Incorporation, which articles and By-laws may thereafter be amemded or repealed by such means

as may be provided in the By-laws.


