ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
EASTERN IDAHO INPATIENT CENTER INC.  
(Non-profit Corporation)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, the undersigned person, being a citizen of the United States of America and of full age, have this day voluntarily offered these articles for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation without capital stock pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and that I do hereby make acknowledge and declare the following to be the Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be EASTERN IDAHO INPATIENT CENTER INC.

ARTICLE II

This Corporation is a non-profit corporation, and shall have no capital stock, and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared to the members thereof.

ARTICLE III

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

1. Education and counseling for alcohol and drug addiction and use.
2. Inpatient housing to assist individuals in the areas of alcohol and drug addiction.
3. Housing of individuals that are under jurisdiction of the court for the purpose of education and counseling for alcohol and drug addiction which has been ordered by the court.
4. Reasonable fee will be charged for the above housing and services in order for the corporation to meet expenses of operation.
5. Eastern Idaho Inpatient Center will operate as a non-profit charitable corporation and will solicit donations in order to provide services, and to provide services for indigent individuals when funds are available.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation shall acquire real estate, housing, and personal property through purchase or donation in order to provide the above services.

ARTICLE V

The location and street address of the registered office and principal place of business shall be 305 E. Lewis, Pocatello, Idaho and the registered agent at that address shall be J. Fredrick McDaniel.

ARTICLE VI

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VII

Bylaws not inconsistent with the articles of incorporation may be adopted, altered, amended or repealed by majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VIII

The business of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors of not less than three. Powers and duties of such directors shall be such as may be prescribed by law, these articles and such bylaws as may from time to time be in force.
