

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

IDAHO SANITARIUM AND HOT SPRINGS COMPANY.

Know All Men by These Presents, that we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation, under the laws of the State of Idaho.

And we hereby certify:-

First. That the name of the said corporation is the "Idaho Sanitarium and Hot Springs Company".

Second. That the purposes for which it is formed are the constructing, improving and maintaining of hotels, health and bathing resorts, hospitals and sanitariums, and the treatment of all diseases; the acquiring and disposing of real estate, water and water rights, and improving the same; the creating and selling of power, and any and all other things convenient or proper to be done in connection with or appertaining to the above purposes.

Third. That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be in the town of Mountain Home in Elmore County, State of Idaho.

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth. That the number of its directors shall be five, and that the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first years are:-
