

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

OF

CANYON SUICIDE PREVENTION HOTLINE, INC.

1. The name of the corporation is CANYON SUICIDE PREVENTION HOTLINE, INC.


2. The amendments herein contained do not alter any provision of the original Articles of Incorporation, but are in addition to the original Articles of Incorporation, and the full text of each provision added is as follows:

a. There shall be added to Article IV the following paragraph:


"This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable or educational purposes within the meaning of §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code."

3. This corporation does not have members other than the duly elected and acting Board of Directors which is composed of 14 persons. That a meeting of the Board of Directors was held on the 16 day of May, 1986, pursuant to proper notice, and a quorum of the members that were entitled to vote were present in person or by proxy and the herein stated amendment to the Articles of Incorporation were adopted by a majority vote of said directors in office.
