CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

GO-KART CLUB OF BURLEY, IDAHO, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twenty-eighth** day of **March** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-one** and is duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Burley** in the County of **Cassia**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, / full-age citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation without capital stock under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be Go-Kart Club of Burley, Idaho, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purposes and objects for which such corporation is formed are as follows:

- A. To manage, regulate, and promote the karting sport in Idaho.
- B. To lease, purchase, or otherwise rent, for the construction and maintenance of a track for racing and operating karts.
- C. To do all other things necessary to carry out the purposes designated above.

ARTICLE III

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

The location and Post Office address of this corporation shall be Burley, County of Cassia, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

This corporation is a non-profit corporation and shall have no

capital stock and shall pay no dividends or salaries to its incorporators, officers or members of the board of directors.

ARTICLE VI

The board of directors of this corporation shall consist of the elected directors, but in no instance shall the number be less than three or more than thirty-five members of the board. The government, membership, and officers, meetings and elections shall be as prescribed by the by-laws of the said corporation.

ARTICLE VII

Pursuant to a notice published in the Burley Herald, a newspaper published in the City of Burley, County of Cassia, for two weeks and posted at Delbert Fenton's Boat Sales and Service, the place of the meeting, for a like period, an election of officers and board of directors of the Go-Kart Club of Burley, Idaho, was held on the 1st day of March, 1961, at Delbert Fenton's Boat Sales and Service, East Main Street, Burley, Idaho, at the hour of 8:00 P.M. A majority of all members were present at such meeting and voted at such election and the result of such election was as follows:
