FIRST; The corporate name and style of this corporation shall be "THE WEYANT MINING COMPANY"

SECCND: The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed and incorporated, is to awa, buy, lease and otherwise acquire Mills and Mill Sites, Mines and Mining property, to sell, lease, convey or otherwise dispose of the same.

To appropriate, own, buy, lease or otherwise acquire water and water rights, canals, acqueducts, ditches, dams, laterals and other means of transporting and using said water rights, to fell, lease and otherwise dispose of the same.

To build, construct, buy, lease or otherwise acquire Mills and Milling property, and to mill, extract, and otherwise reduce mineral ores: To buy, contract for or treat custom ores for profit and to sell and dispose of the products of the same;

To sell, lease and otherwise dispose of said mills and milling property or any part thereof;
