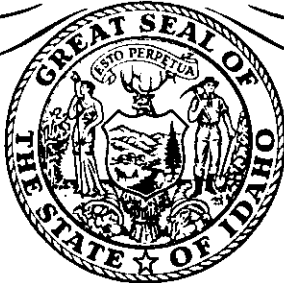

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at Kooskia, Idaho in the County of Idaho and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

FIRST UNITED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF KOOSKIA, IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, members of the First United Presbyterian Church of Kooskia, Idaho, all being natural citizens of the United States of America, of legal age, and residents and citizens of the State of Idaho, pursuant to the expressed desires and direction of the membership of said organization, do hereby, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and particularly of the provisions of Title Thirty, Chapter Eleven, of the Idaho Code, associate ourselves together and form a corporation, and for that purpose do certify as follows:

I

The name of this corporation is the First United Presbyterian Church of Kooskia, Idaho, Inc.

II

a. The purpose of the corporation shall be to form the congregation into one body with its own rights, privileges and liabilities. To transact the business of the church under its By-Laws and under the constitution of the United Presbyterian Church in the United States of America.

b. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, members of the Board of Session, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propagands, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including

the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

b. (2) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Session shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Session shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

c. To do any and all other things which may be requested, necessary or proper, in the accomplishment of the purposes and objects for which the corporation is formed.

### III

This corporation shall have perpetual existence and succession by its corporate name.

### IV

The location and post office address of the corporation's registered office in the State of Idaho shall be Kooskia, Idaho.

### V

This corporation shall have no capital stock, and shall not engage in business for profit.

## VI

This corporation shall have a Board of Session, which board shall have the management and control of the real property of the corporation, as well as the control of the promotion, operation and maintenance of the corporation. The Board of Session shall be elected and organized in accordance with the By-Laws adopted by the First United Presbyterian Church of Kooskia, Idaho.

## VII

Those becoming members of the First United Presbyterian Church of Kooskia, Idaho, shall thereby be entitled to membership in this corporation. The qualifications of members, the mode of election, and terms of admission to memberships; the expulsion and suspension of members for misconduct; or other reasons; the requirements for restoration to membership; the contracting, securing, paying, and limiting of the amount of indebtedness, and all other regulations that are to be effective in the conduct of the corporate business, shall be provided for in the By-Laws of this corporation.
