

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE ALDER CREEK MINING COMPANY, (LIMITED).

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a Corporation, under the laws of the State of Idaho.

And we hereby certify: First, That the name of said Corporation is The Alder Creek Mining Company (Limited).

Second, That the purposes for which it is formed are to carry on the business of mining, milling, smelting; buying, selling, and holding real estate, mining claims; acquiring water rights; and buying and selling ore; and do all things necessary and appurtenant to carry on the business of mining and handling ore.

Third, That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the town of Mackay, Custer county, Idaho.

Fourth, That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth, That the number of its Directors shall be five (5), and that the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are:
