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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PONOZZO & CO., P.A.

ARTICLE I CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES
