



AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

GRACE BAPTIST CHURCH OF TWIN FALLS, IDAHO

3. PURPOSES AND OBJECTS. The purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are:
- a. To maintain a general church organization and to do and perform all acts usual and incidental to the maintenance and operation of a religious corporation.
 - b. To encourage social fellowship among its members and friends, and to assist in improving the moral, social, and religious conditions of the community of Twin Falls, Idaho, and the outlying area.
 - c. To purchase and own such real and personal property as may be necessary for the purposes of the church organization.
 - d. To receive donations for carrying out the purposes of the corporation, and to receive, manage, take, own and hold, real and personal property, by gift, grant, devise, and bequest.
 - e. To do and perform all the usual acts of a general church organization, and to promote Christian living through Christian education for the general welfare of the members of the corporation and the general community.




