### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

#### **LIGHTNING CREEK TRAIL RIDERS INC.**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twentieth** day of **February,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-three** and is duly recorded on Film No. **122** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for

**perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

**Clark Fork** in the County of **Bonner**

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, ~~Robert~~ E. Ralph, George C. Moore, Wally Erickson, Arne Gunderson, Edna Dettwiler; all of whom are of full legal age, residents and citizens of Bonner County, Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the laws of the state of Idaho, and we do hereby certify as follows:-

### ARTICLE I

That the name of this Association shall be "Lightning Creek Trail Riders Inc" and its location shall be in Clark Fork, Idaho.

### ARTICLE II

That the business and purpose of such corporation shall be:

To establish and maintain suitable grounds and tracks for the display of horses and horse shows in the county of Bonner, with necessary buildings, erections and improvements, and to conduct on said grounds and tracks horse racing, exhibitions, and contests of speed, and races of every kind and description for premiums, purses, and other awards made up from fees or otherwise, and to charge the public for admission thereto and to said grounds and tracks, and to let such rights and privileges to others; to conduct restaurants, cafes, and other stands for the sale of food and other refreshments to persons on said premises, and to let the privilege of conducting the same to others, and to do and perform all other acts necessary for fully accomplishing the purposes herein before specifically enumerated. To do all things that may be properly done incidental to the foregoing purposes, and to have all the rights and privileges in this state which accrue to manufacturing and business corporations under the laws of the state of Idaho.

To purchase, receive, lease as lessee, or in any manner acquire, own, hold, maintain, use, sell, convey, lease as lessor, exchange, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of any and all real and personal property or any interest therein necessary, useful or appropriate to enable this Association to accomplish any and all of its purposes.

To acquire, own, hold, use, exercise and, to the extent permitted by law, to sell, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate and in any manner dispose of franchises, rights, privileges, licenses, rights-of-way and easements necessary, useful or appropriate to accomplish any and all of the purposes of this Association.

To borrow money, to make and issue bonds, notes, bills of exchange, debentures and other evidences of indebtedness, secured or unsecured, for moneys borrowed or in payment for property acquired, or for any of the other objects or purposes of the Association; to secure the payment of such bonds, bills of exchange, debentures, notes or other evidences of indebtedness by mortgage, or mortgages, or deed or deeds of trust, upon, or by the pledge of or other lien upon, any or all of the property, rights, privileges of franchises of the Association, wheresoever situated, acquired or to be acquired.

To do all such things as may be useful, necessary or convenient for the accomplishment of the purposes of this Article expressed, or any of them; provided, however, that the operations of this Association shall not be for pecuniary profit to this Association or its members, but shall be for the mutual benefit of the members.

### ARTICLE III

The duration of this Association shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE IV

The corporation is not organized for the pecuniary profit, nor shall it have any power to issue certificates of stock, or declare dividends, and no part of its net earning shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, or individual.

The balance, if any, of all money received by the corporation from its operations, after the payment in full of all debts and obligations of the corporation, of whatsoever kind and nature, shall be used and distributed exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes.

### ARTICLE V

The rights and interests of all members of this Association shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

No capital stock shall be issued, but membership shall be evidenced by membership certificates issued to each member thereof. Said certificates cannot be assigned or transferred so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the Association, except by resolution of the Board of Directors, and under regulations as prescribed by the by-laws.

### ARTICLE VI

The location and post office address of the registered office of this Association, shall be, Clark Fork, Idaho.

### ARTICLE VII

The private property of the members of this corporation shall not be liable for its corporate debts.

### ARTICLE VIII

The number of directors of said corporation shall be five (5).

### ARTICLE IX

The directors of said corporation shall be elected from its members.
