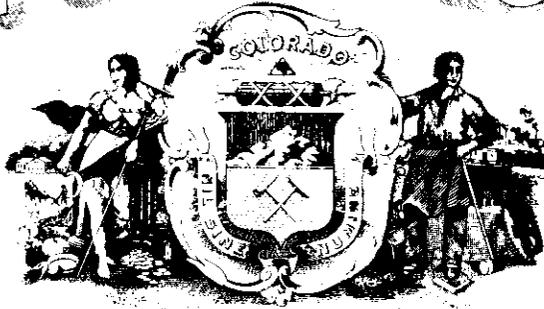

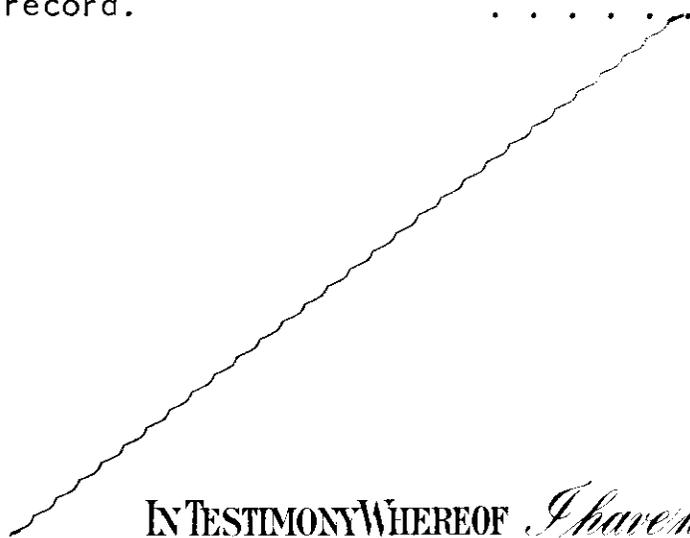

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ALDORA, INC.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Colorado Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Aldora, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and to transfer or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and with real property or personal property of every class and description for and on account of the corporation or as factor, agent, nominee or otherwise for or on behalf of another; and to have and exercise any and all powers now or hereafter by law conferred upon or allowed to corporations organized for similar purposes.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares of stock which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 10,000 shares with Par Value of \$1.00 per share.

FIFTH: Cumulative voting of shares of stock is not authorized.

SIXTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 544 Acoma Street, Denver, Colorado, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is NORMAN J. GRAY.

SEVENTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is Three (3); and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of stockholders or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:

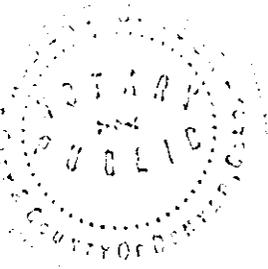
