I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Second** day of **December**, A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-three** and duly recorded on Film No. **126** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada**.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
AVERY TRUCKING CO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all of whom are of full age and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together and do hereby and by these Articles of Incorporation unite and associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho for the purpose hereinafter stated:

I.

The name of this corporation shall be AVERY TRUCKING CO.

II.

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be in perpetuity.

III.

The location of the registered office and post office address of the corporation shall be Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

IV.

The object and purposes for which this corporation is formed shall be and are:

- (a) To engage in the general transportation business of transporting persons and property for compensation by motor vehicle, aircraft, water craft and other means of conveyances as a common carrier or otherwise, and to acquire, own, operate, lease and dispose of such businesses.
- (b) To construct, purchase, acquire, lease or otherwise operate storage warehouses and storage facilities for the storage and deposit of goods and merchandise of every kind or nature.
- (c) To engage in the rental, loan and lease of automobiles, trucks, tractors, trailers and, without limitation, all types of motor vehicles and to perform necessary services in connection with such leasing, loaning, and rental of such vehicles.
- (d) To apply for, acquire, hold, own, purchase, sell or transfer any and all licenses, permits, certificates, franchises and authority necessary or useful in the conduct of its business.
- (e) To acquire, hold, sell, transfer, dispose of or otherwise deal in the assets or good will of any business of the nature authorized by the objects or purposes of this corporation; and to hold, utilize and in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the assets, good will and rights so acquired; and to conduct in whole or in part any business so acquired; and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the liabilities or obligations of any person, firm, association or corporation from whom a business is so acquired.
- (f) To purchase, lease, hold, improve, sell and convey real estate and to construct, lease and maintain thereon such buildings or improvements as may be necessary for conducting the business of the corporation either within or without the State of Idaho.
- (g) To purchase, own, hold, vote, sell or hypothecate the stocks and bonds of other corporations and to take in the name of the corporation such stock, bonds, mortgages, notes, deeds, conveyances or other evidence of indebtedness, ownership, title or security as may be acquired by the corporation in the transaction of its business.

(h) To borrow and lend money and contract debts, when considered necessary or desirable for the transaction of the business of this corporation or for the exercise of the corporate rights, privileges or franchise, or for any other lawful purpose; to issue bonds, promissory notes, bills of exchange, debentures and other obligations and other evidences of indebtedness, payable at a specified time or times, or payable upon the happening of a specified event or events, whether secured by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, or unsecured, for money borrowed or in payment for property purchased or acquired, or for any other lawful object; and to issue, sell, and dispose of certificates or investment or participation certificates, to the extent permitted by law.

(i) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts and agreements of every kind and nature which may be necessary or desirable for the furtherance of the business of this corporation, with any person, firm, corporation, association, governmental body or body politic, wherever located.

(j) To conduct the business of this corporation at any place or places within the State of Idaho, or in any other state or territory of the United States, or in any foreign country, and to have one or more offices within or outside of the State of Idaho.

This corporation may engage in any lawful activity. The purposes as specified herein shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from any other clause or paragraph of these Articles of Incorporation; and the purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses or paragraphs of these Articles of Incorporation shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers; and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrain in any manner the general powers and the general purposes now or hereafter conferred on this corporation by the applicable statutes of the State of Idaho.

V.

Section 1: The business of this corporation shall be managed and conducted by a Board of not less than three (3) nor more than seven (7) Directors as may be set forth in the By-Laws.

Section 2: The Board of Directors of this corporation may meet and transact the business of this corporation either at the principal place of business herein designated or at such other place, within or without the State of Idaho, as may be designated by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 3: The Board of Directors shall, in addition to their other powers, have the power to repeal and amend the By-Laws of the corporation and to adopt new By-Laws.

VI.

This corporation is authorized to issue one class of shares of capital stock which shall be designated "common stock." The total number of shares of common stock which this corporation shall be authorized to issue is 250 shares which shares shall have no par value.

VII.
