RESOLVED, that this Company and the stockholders of this Company hereby authorize the dissolution of this Company, the settling of its business, the disposing of its property, and the dividing of its capital stock, all at such times and in such manner as the Board of Directors shall determine; and that the Board of Directors and officers of the Company be and they are hereby authorized to take, from time to time, any and all action and proceedings necessary or appropriate, in their discretion, to consummate the purposes of this resolution."

I further certify that the directors of said The Oregon Railroad and Mavigation Company, at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors of said corporation duly convened and held on December 23, 1910, by unanimous vote of 11 directors present at said meeting, constituting a quorum and more than a majority of the 15 directors comprising said Board, duly adopted a resolution to dissolve said corporation and certain preambles thereto, of

which resolution and prosmbles the following is a full and true copy:

"DISCOLUTION OF COMPANY.

On motion, duly made and seconded, the following preambles

and resolution were unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, pursuant to action of this Board at its meeting held on November 29, 1910, and the approval and ratification of said action by the stockholders of this Company at a special meeting held on December 22, 1910, all the railroad and telegraph lines and substantially all other property of this Company have been sold to Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, and will be conveyed and transferred to said Company as of 11:59 o'clock P.M., Pacific Coast time, this 23rd day of December, 1910,

WHEREAS, the stockholders of this Company, at a special meeting called for such purpose, held on the 22nd day of December, 1910, by vote of more than a majority of the stock of this Company, authorized the dissolution of this Company, the settling of its business, the disposing of its property, and the dividing of its capital stock, all in such manner as this Board shall determine:

RESOLVED, that, pursuant to the aforesaid authorization of the stockholders, this Company be for thwith dissolved; that, as soon as may be, the business of the Company be settled, its assets collected, its debts, obligations, and liabilities paid and discharged, and, subject to the making of proper and sufficient provision to secure the payment of any obligations and liabilities of the Company unmatured and not payable, the surplus assets and capital stock of the Company be divided among the stockholders; and that the officers of this Company be and they are hereby authorized and directed, under the direction of the President, to take any and all action and proceedings, in the name and in to take any and all action and proceedings, in the name and in behalf of the Company, necessary or appropriate to consumnate the purposes of this resolution."

I further certify that pursuant to the foregoing resolutions said The Oregon Railroad and Navigation Company is proceeding to dissolve.
