And we hereby certify:

First: That the name of said corporation is The Standard Printing Company Ltd.

Second: That the purposes for which it is organized are to carry on a general printing, publishing, and stationery business.

Third: that the place where its principle business is to be transacted shall be the City of Grangeville State of Idaho.

Fourth: That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after its incorporation.

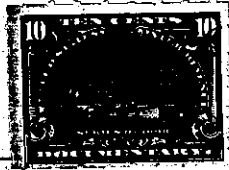
